For Delta State University students who are not majoring in education, we offer a non-teaching minor.

This 18 hour course sequence does not result in teaching licensure, nor can it be used as supplemental endorsement to a teaching license. Instead, it is designed primarily for individuals seeking careers in the helping professions such as social work, psychology, child development and speech and hearing sciences.
