DSU Grants Process – A Step-by-Step Guide that takes you from program concept through award notification.

Grants Resources – includes University policies and forms related to external funding, links to federal regulations and other items of interest, and recent Grants Office newsletters.

Private and Corporate funding – a database of private and corporate funders interested in funding projects in our region that is listed by focus areas.
