MAT 492. Special Topics in Mathematics (Issues in Secondary Mathematics Education). Teaching interns will analyze and reflect on teaching experiences. (3 hours credit)

Requirements:

At the end of each week of teaching, the candidate is expected to reflect on the week's lessons, the planning, the teaching, the student response, and feedback from the cooperating teacher. On the following Monday, a short narrative will be due which addresses the following ideas.

- What lesson or activity went very well? Why do you think that it went well? (Include lesson plan for the day.)
- What lesson or activity did not go very well? Why do you think that it did not go well? (Include lesson plan for the day.)
- Identify something that needs improvement in your teaching. Write some steps that you can take to help with the improvement.

Journal articles related to mathematics education will be read. The candidate will read the article and write a reaction. Discussion of the article with the instructor will be expected.
