All Praxis exams must be passed before applying for the three-year license or beginning the internship. MAT students must maintain a 3.0 overall GPA on the MAT program (B average). To determine the Praxis 2 test number you need, be sure to check the Mississippi Department of Education website (www.mdek12.org)

A comprehensive exam must be passed during the semester in which the candidate plans to graduate.

<u>To apply for the three-year license:</u> Wait until grades for the semester have posted to your transcript (check MyDSU). Send an email to <u>apowers@deltastate.edu</u> and CC <u>reacord@deltastate.edu</u> requesting verification for your three-year MAT license. Be sure to include first name, last name, 900#, major (elementary or secondary), and subject area.

<u>To apply for the five-year license:</u> Follow the steps above and be sure to ask for verification of your 5-year MAT license.

<u>After graduation:</u> You will complete an application for an AA license through the educator portal with the Mississippi Department of Education. Be sure to send your completed DSU transcript after your degree has been conferred on the transcript. This usually occurs 2-3 weeks after graduation.
