

The Academic Council, chaired by the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs, is composed of the Deans of the Colleges of Arts and Sciences, Business, and Education; Dean of the School of Nursing; Deans of Graduate Studies, Library Services, and Enrollment; the President of the Faculty Senate; the Registrar; the Dean for Assessment and Planning; the Director of the Center for Community and Economic Development; and the Associate Dean of the Delta Center for Culture and Learning.

The Academic Council is advisory to the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs in matters related to the academic administration of the University. In that capacity it will consider topics that impact the University's academic programs and issues related to the University's academic mission. The Council provides a forum for developing procedures for implementing academic policies; developing and implementing new and revised academic policies and procedures; monitoring enrollment trends; facilitating program improvement and expansion; addressing resolutions put forward by the Faculty Senate; and considering other academic issues as may be brought before it. As appropriate, the Council makes recommendations to the President's Cabinet.
