Call the Question	refers to the Main Motion and closes debate and requires an immediate Vote	Not Debatable 2/3 of Members Present
Limit or Extend Debate	shortens or lengths the usual debate time limit	Not Debatable 2/3 of Members Present
Point of Information	to ask the Chair a question related to the process or Motion	Granted by the Chair
Point of Order	to ask the Chair a question related to rules	Granted by the Chair; Chair rules upon question
Table/Lift from Table	to suppress a Motion/return to it	Not Debatable Majority Vote
