SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the parliamentarian shall be granted special privilege of remaining in the senate during executive sessions for the purpose of good conduct of the senate.
SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appointment of the parliamentarian be at the request of the President of the Faculty Senate and the consent of a simple majority of the Faculty Senate for the nominee.
SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be presented to the President's Cabinet for their information,
