# Mississippi Tuition Assistance Grant (MTAG)

## Award Amount/Length of Eligibility:

- Up to \$500/year for freshmen & sophomores
- Up to \$1,000/year for juniors & seniors
- Max 8 semesters/12 trimesters

## **Initial Eligibility Requirements:**

- Cumulative 2.5 GPA
- 15 ACT
- Must not be eligible for full federal Pell Grant
- Mississippi Resident
- Full-time enrollment at eligible Mississippi institution

Application dates: September 15

Document deadline: October 15

## Mississippi Eminent Scholars Grant (MESG)

#### Award Amount/Length of Eligibility:

- Up to \$2,500/year
- Max 8 semesters/12 trimesters

#### **Initial Eligibility Requirements:**

- Cumulative 3.5 GPA
- 29 ACT
- Mississippi Resident
- Full-time enrollment at eligible Mississippi institution

Application dates: September 15

Document deadline: October 15

# Higher Education Legislative Plan (HELP)

#### Award Amount/Length of Eligibility:

- Tuition and fees at a public institution
- Max 8 semesters/12 trimesters

#### Initial Eligibility Requirements:

- Cumulative 2.5 GPA
- 20 ACT
- Must complete FAFSA—can be full Pell eligible
- Must complete HELP Core Curriculum
- Must provide evidence of annual family Adjusted Gross
  Income
- Mississippi Resident
- Full-time enrollment at eligible Mississippi institution

Application Deadline: March 31

Document deadline: April 30



Undergraduate students must enroll in and complete 15 credit hours per semester to maintain eligibility for state aid for programs that require full-time enrollment.
