1. Anyone is eligible to submit entries in any category.
2. Students may submit no more than 2 per category.
3. All entries must include:
  - a. Entry Form
  - b. Paper Product
  - c. PDF Format copy
  - d. On a CD – Map mxd and database
4. Thematic and Reference maps must be on a minimum of 11"x17" paper and maximum of 24"x36" paper.
5. Book/Atlas maps must be on a minimum of 8.5" x 11" paper and a maximum of 11" x 17".
6. The GIT Center at DSU is available for use during regular working hours.
