Proposal Application | Deadline: October 31, 2012

OIT's Instructional Technology department will be organizing and administering another funding opportunity for DSU faculty.

If you have in mind a compelling instructional technology project idea, but you don't have the necessary hardware, software, or digital devices to make it happen, here's your chance!

The awards will range in value from \$500 to \$1,000, and funding will go to the project proposal ideas that show the most promise for improving student learning outcomes across disciplines.

All grant proposals should be submitted via email attachment in Word (DOC) or PDF formats to Dr. Nicole House (nhouse@deltastate.edu) on or before October 31, 2012. Grant awards will be announced on November 06, 2012.

Proposals should include the following information: Your name, academic title, department, email address, and office phone number.

The OIT Challenge Grant proposal should consist of no more than four pages. Page one is the Cover Sheet. The second page begins the body of the proposal with the Proposal Summary highlights. The third page consists of: Background, Activities and an Evaluation Plan. The last page should contain the Technology Budget.
