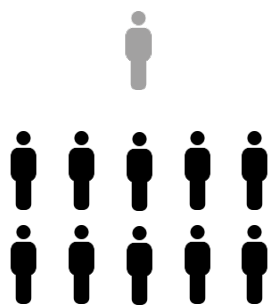

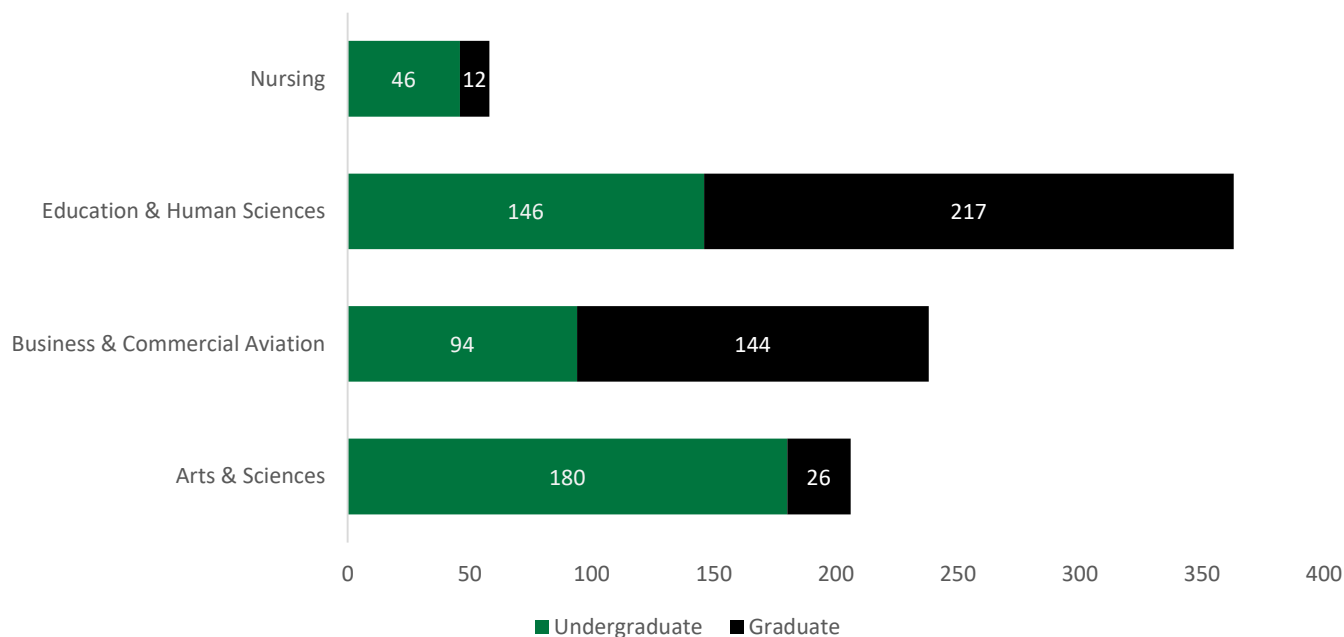

### 2021-22 Degrees Awarded by College



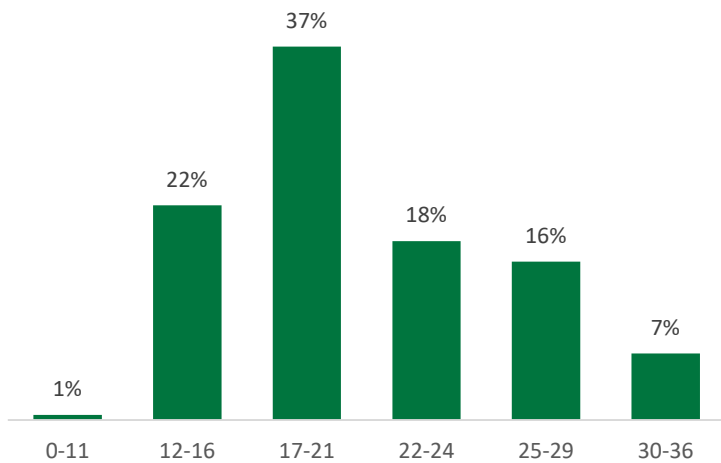

### Fall 2022 ACT Composite Score Distribution



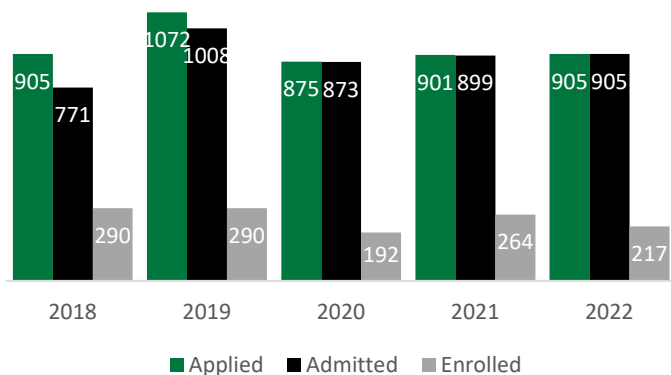

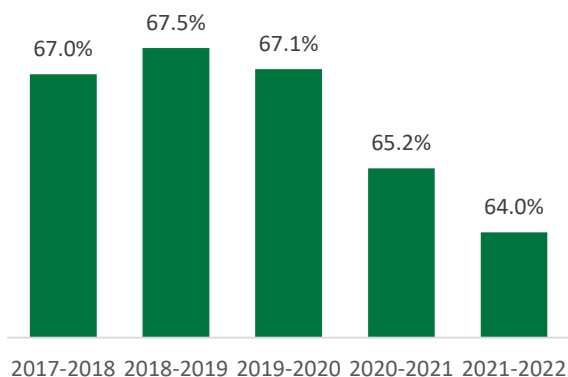
