May 2017 Graduates

If graduation requirements will not be completed by the end of the spring 2017 semester, it is imperative that you contact the Registrar's Office by April 7, 2017 to inactivate your application. THIS FEE WILL NOT BE REMOVED AFTER THIS DATE and an additional \$45 fee will be charged when you submit a new graduation application.

Diplomas:

All diplomas will be mailed unless the Registrar's office is notified otherwise. Students who wish to pick up their diploma from the Registrar's office should email request to: registrar@deltastate.edu. No diplomas will be given out prior to June 8, 2017.

No diplomas will be mailed or handed out unless all fees have been paid and all student holds have been cleared.

Financial Aid Exit Interviews

Cap and Gown:
