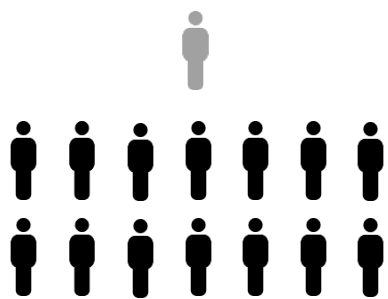

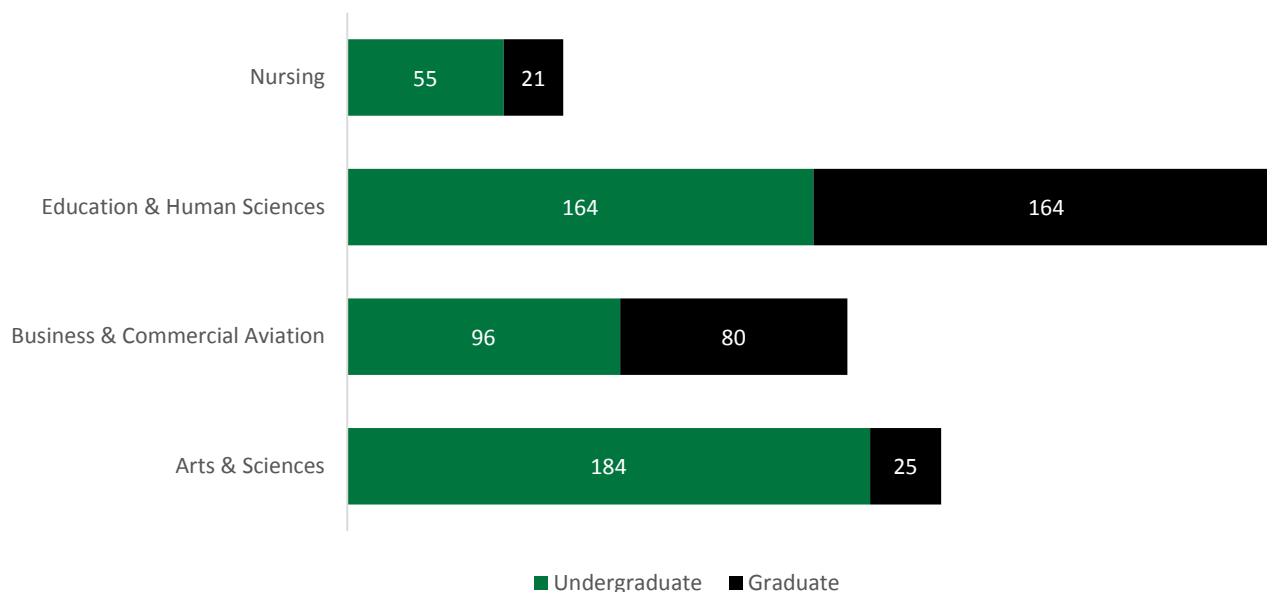

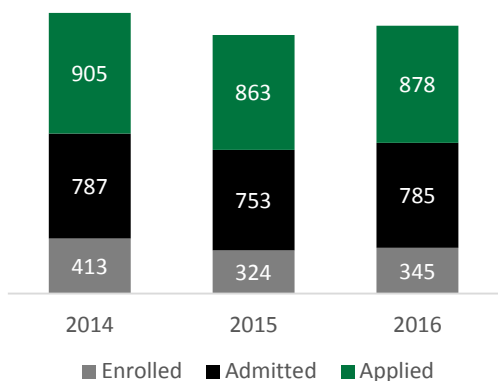

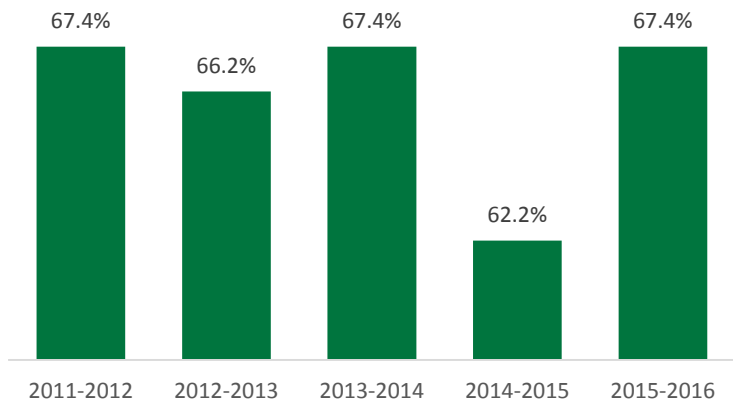

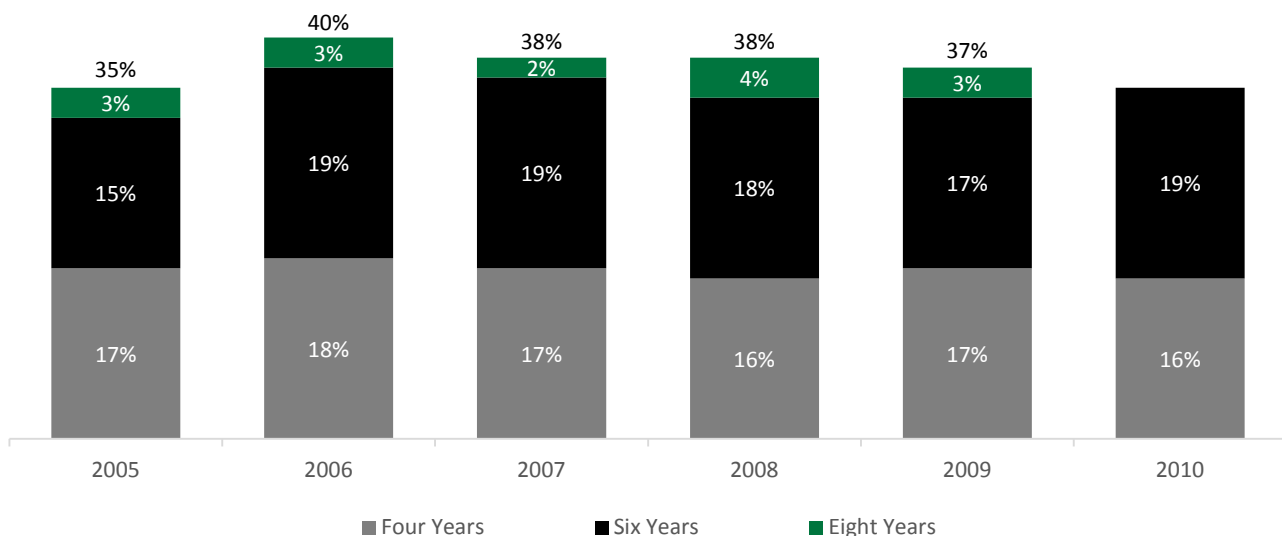
New Freshmen Applied, Admitted, and Enrolled



One-Year Retention Rate of Full-Time, Degree-Seeking New Freshmen



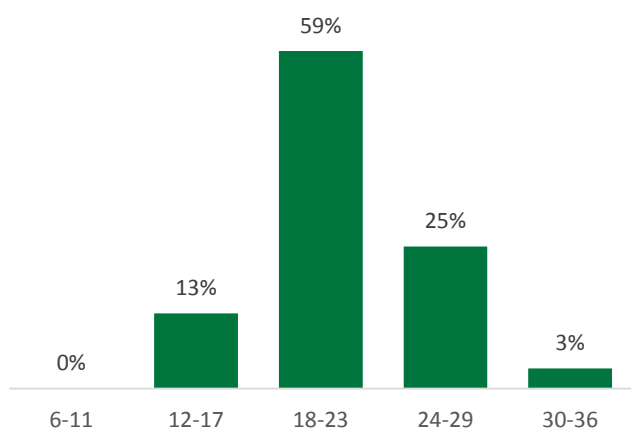
Graduation Rate for Full-Time, First-Time, Degree-Seeking Freshmen
