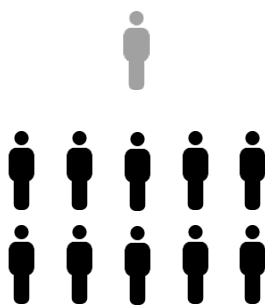

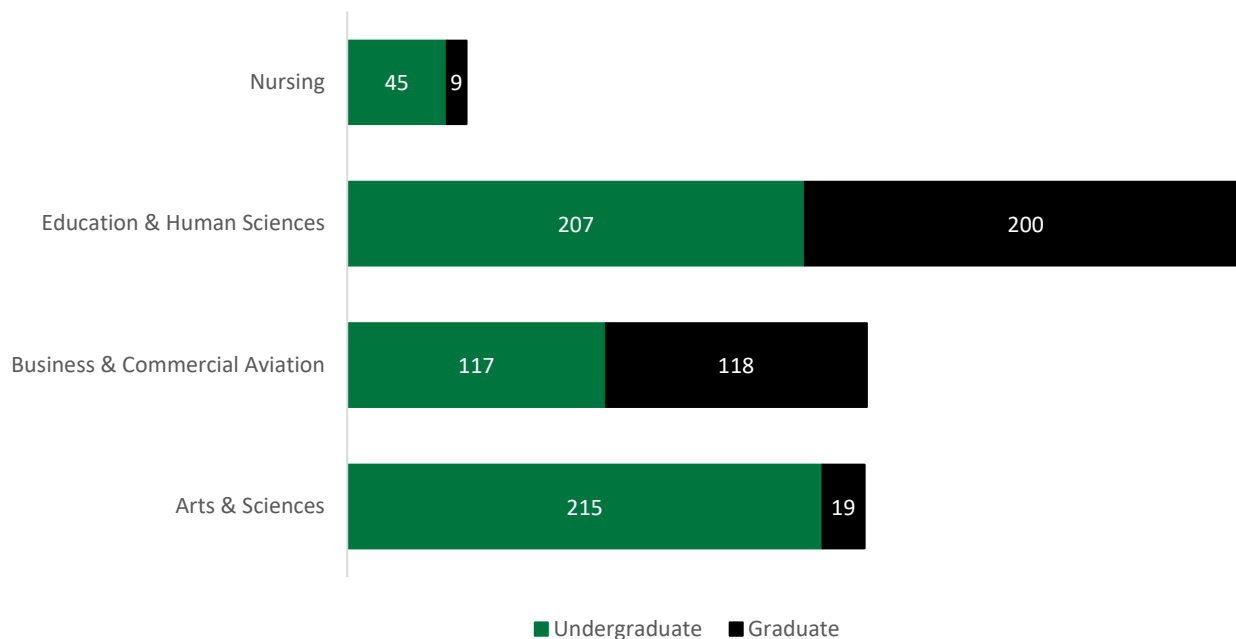

### 2020-21 Degrees Awarded by College



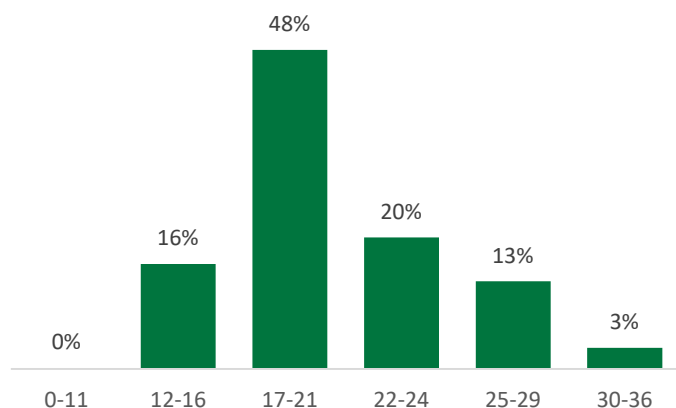

### Fall 2021 ACT Composite Score Distribution



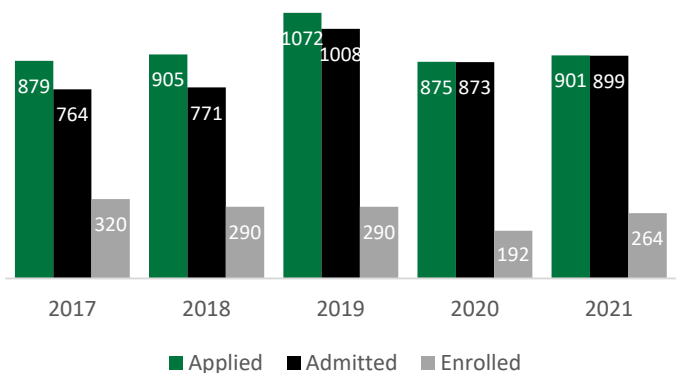

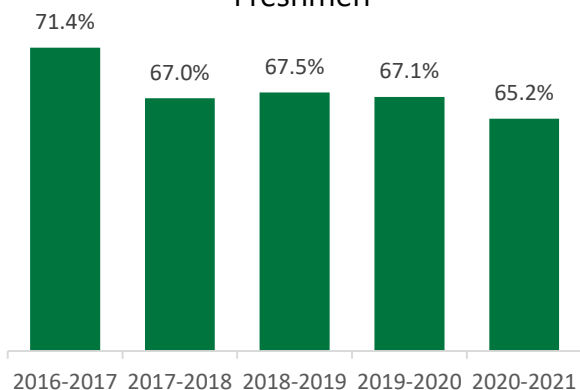
