

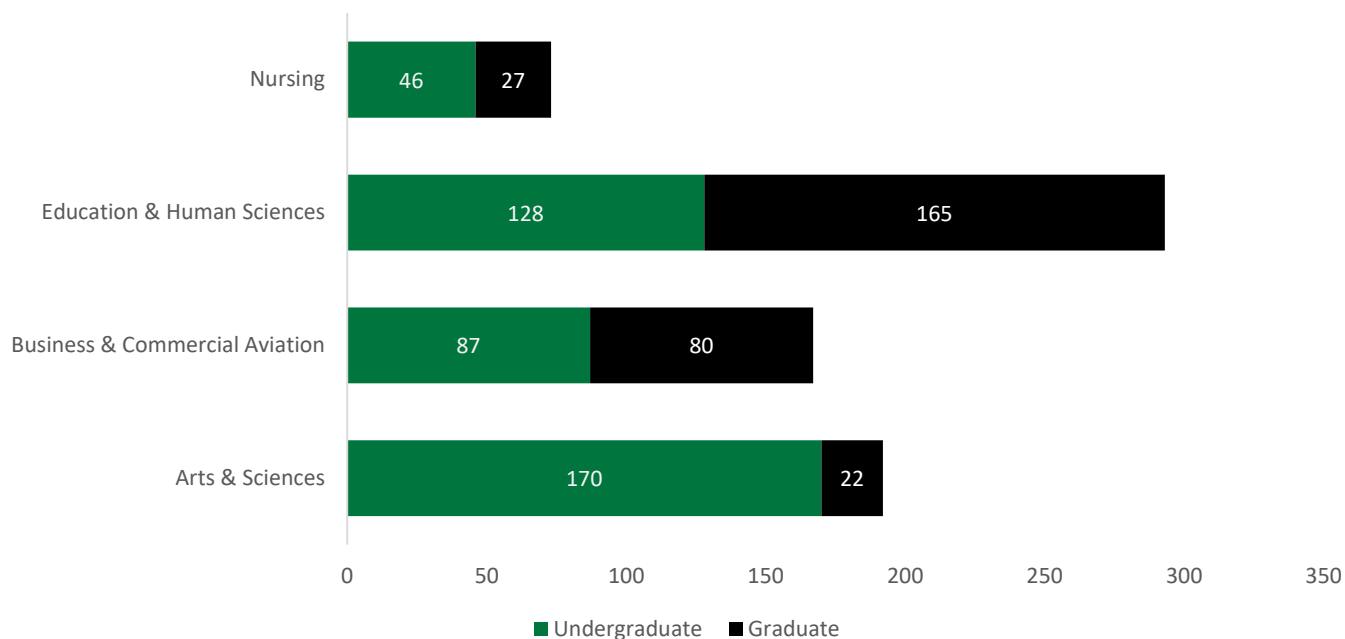

### 2022-23 Degrees Awarded by College



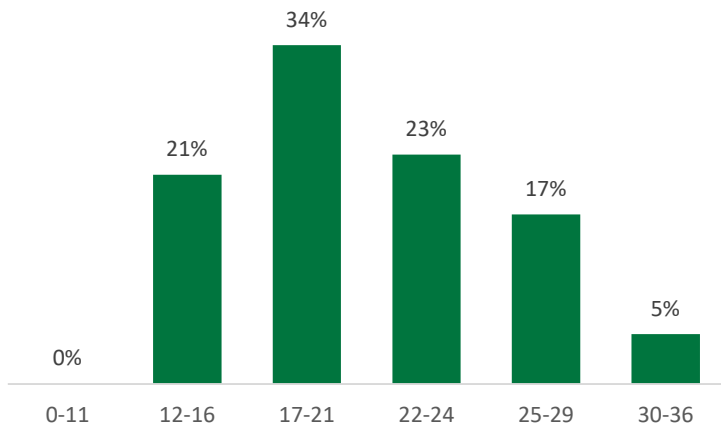

### Fall 2023 ACT Composite Score Distribution



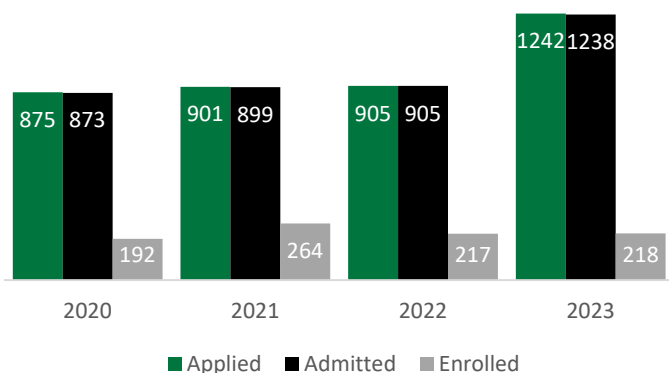

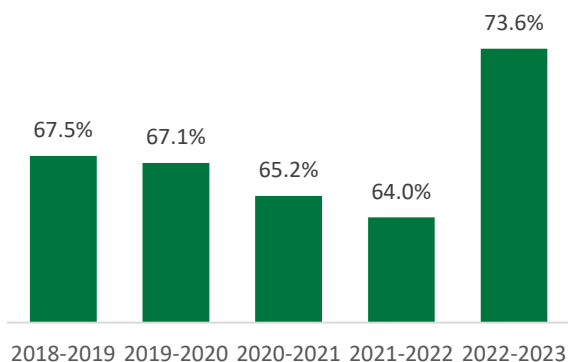
