1. Private Lesson (beginners - early intermediate students): \$285  One 30-min. private lesson per week with a student teacher or Johnathan Williams.  A master class with teachers of the DSU Piano Preparatory Program or a guest clinician; and a final recital.  Books are included.
2. Private Lesson (beginners - early intermediate students): \$525  Two 30-min. private lessons per week with a student teacher or Johnathan Williams.  A master class with teachers of the DSU Piano Preparatory Program or a guest clinician; and a final recital.  Books are included.
3. Private Lesson (late beginners - early intermediate students): \$405 One 45-min. private lesson per week with a student teacher or Johnathan Williams. A master class with teachers of the DSU Piano Preparatory Program or a guest clinician; and a final recital. Books are included.
4. Private Lesson (late beginners - early intermediate students): \$495*  One 45-min. private lesson per week with DSU piano faculty.  A master class with teachers of the DSU Piano Preparatory Program or a guest clinician; and a final recital.  Books are NOT included.

### Policies:

• COVID-19 and Sickness: Due to the size of each lesson room, students and teachers must wear masks (and other instructor-identified PPE, if recommended) in the lesson room at all times, sanitize their hands before and after each lesson, and maintain a social distance while in the lesson room. Teachers will sanitize piano keyboards and lids, and door knobs, and ventilate lesson rooms before and after each lesson. Lessons will occur in Bailey Hall in 122, 135, and 136.

Any student or teacher that has symptoms or has been exposed to someone with COVID-19 must immediately self-quarantine, report the case to Dr. Jung-Won Shin, and lessons will be made online temporarily until a safe return can be ensured or lessons will be rescheduled. All confirmed and suspected Covid-19 cases will be monitored.

Students and teachers should not come to lessons if they are experiencing an illness of any kind. In that case, lessons will be rescheduled or held online.

- Child's Safety: Each child is required to be accompanied by his/her parent or guardian to and from his/her scheduled studio or practice room for all lessons and rehearsals. If a parent/guardian decides to allow his/her child to walk to and from a studio or practice room without an adult, the parent/guardian waives the recommendations of the Delta State University (DSU) Piano Preparatory Program for the safety of his/her child. In case of emergency, the DSU Piano Preparatory Program will first contact child's parent/guardian, then the DSU Police Department.
- Make-Up Class or Lesson: There will be no make-up group piano class. For private lessons, two make-up lessons for excused absences will be allowed to each student when lessons were cancelled by the student at least three hours before the weekly lesson time. There will be make-up lessons if weekly lessons were cancelled by instructors.
- **Tuition and Fees**: All tuition and fees for each semester should be paid in full at the time of student's registration in the beginning of each semester.
- **Refund Policy**: There will be no tuition credit for students who miss lessons.

  Tuition will be partially refunded if students fully withdraw from the program by the fifth week of the current semester. No refunds will be made after the fifth week. A 10% discount on tuition for the next semester will be given to students who withdraw from the program during the sixth and seventh weeks of the current semester. Book fees are non-refundable if books have already been used by students.
