■ What are the eligibility requirements?

- Must be a Mississippi resident
- Must be accepted into the Summer Developmental Program (SDP) at an eligible institution of higher learning
- Must be eligible to receive federal student financial aid and demonstrate financial need

■ How do I apply?

■ Apply online as early as January 1 but no later than July 21 at www.mississippi.edu (click on Financial Aid).

What documents will I be required to provide?

- A copy of your parent's current year State of Mississippi tax return; and
- The results from completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid; or other documents approved by the Mississippi Office of Student Financial Aid





■ How will I be notified if I am awarded?

■ The Mississippi Office of Student Financial Aid will notify you of a grant offer by an award letter and will notify your school about the award.

■ What is the award amount of my grant?

Awards are dependent upon your demonstrated financial need; however, no grant will exceed financial need or the total cost of attendance.

■ Is my grant renewable each year?

■ No, this is a non-renewable grant.
