

1. Go to <https://apply.deltastate.edu/Undergraduate/Pages/welcome.aspx>
2. Log in using your e-mail and DSU application site password. If you do not already have an account to the application site, you can create one by clicking, **“Not registered yet? Create an account!”**
3. Begin filling in the application according to the instructions on the screen.
4. Select the semester you would like to begin classes, and select **Complete to Compete-BUS-C2C** as your academic program. **Selecting this program is vital, as it is the only way to indicate to the Admissions office that you are a C2C student!**
