2018-2019 F-1 Declaration of Financial Support

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) requires that all F-1 students show proof of financial support for each year of university study in the United States. To meet this requirement, all F-1 students must submit:

- 1. A financial affidavit signed by the student and sponsor(s).
- 2. A bank statement or other comparable evidence of financial stability. This official document must be dated within six months of the start of the semester and be signed, dated and stamped by bank official.

The current minimum amount required per academic year is \$19,566 for a student even if receiving any scholarship assistance (add \$5000 for your spouse and \$3000 for each child listed as your dependent). These amounts are subject to change without prior notice. This form should be used only by students who are sponsored by self, family members, or personal friends. Those who have official government or agency sponsors should submit their sponsor documents.

CONTRACT FOR UNIVERSITY RESIDENCE HALLS

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Rooms may be occupied ONLY by students to whom they are assigned. Room transfers must be made and approved prior to moving only at times specified by the Housing Office. Residence hall requests should be made as early as possible and mutual requests must be made at the same time to be guaranteed. Delta State University is a tobacco-free campus, this includes the residence halls. Prior to occupancy, you will be required to sign an Academic Year Contract. Please be sure to read it carefully, it does bind you financially. All rooms must be claimed by 5 p.m. on the University's first day of class.

RESIDENCY POLICY

Any full time student under 21 years of age, who has completed fewer than 30 earned college semester hours will be required to live on-campus for one academic year (two semesters). Exceptions are made for married students, single parents, recent war veterans, and for those students who live with their parents or legal guardians and commute from a distance of no more than 30 miles. Married students are required to submit a copy of their marriage license. A single parent is required to submit a copy of the child's birth certificate. Exemption requests must be submitted in writing to the Office of Housing & Residence Life. The written appeal should include your reason for appeal and must be mailed to Housing & Residence Life, DSU Box B-3 Cleveland, MS 38733 or emailed to housing@deltastate.edu. Single freshmen who enroll and are found to be living off campus without an authorized exemption will be billed for one semester's housing fee.

PRIVATE ROOMS

Private rooms are not guaranteed at the beginnings of any semester. If space is available at a later date, requests may be granted on a first come, first serve basis. There is an additional fee for a private room. Private room fees are payable in the same manner as other fees. A STUDENT LIVING ALONE ON THE FIRST FRIDAY OF EACH TERM WILL BE REQUIRED TO COME TO THE HOUSING OFFICE FOR REASSIGNMENT WITH A ROOMMATE OR PAY PRIVATE ROOM FEES REGARDLESS OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES THAT CAUSED THE SINGLE OCCUPANCY. You will be charged for a private room from the date you become the only occupant of that room.

CHARGES/DAMAGES

At the time of occupancy you will be checked into your room by a member of the residence hall staff and a record will be made of the condition of the room and its contents. You are responsible for damages to or loss of any room property. Charges will be assessed for any damages beyond fair wear and tear. These charges are applied to your student account and can be paid in the same manner as other fees. All thefts, damage to property, etc. should be reported immediately to the Resident Assistant, Assistant Hall Director, Residence Hall Director, and DSU Police Department. The university is not liable for the loss of or damage to any or all student property regardless of the location on campus.

INSPECTION OF ROOMS

The university reserves the right to inspect the living quarters of any student residing in University property at any time that its administrative officials or their agents shall deem such inspection to be in the best interest of the university and/or to protect campus order and the safety and well-being of students, faculty, staff or others.
