

Graduation Application Process

Effective immediately, the Registrar's office is implementing a more efficient, totally online Graduation Application process, handled via DSU Online Services. All students who are planning to graduate this spring, May 2012, or any semester thereafter, must apply using the new procedure. Paper applications will no longer be processed.

Graduate students must have completed at least 18 earned credit hours (not including the current semester) **in order to apply for graduation.**

The new application process will be available for student use starting Monday, February 6, 2012. Students who plan to graduate in May, 2012 must apply between Monday, February 6, 2012, and Monday, April 2, 2012. Students who wish to graduate in subsequent semesters (December 2012, for example) must also apply online. Students who have already submitted a paper application **must reapply** via the online process. Students seeking dual degrees/majors must submit an application for each degree/major.

February 6 – November 5, 2012
