EDUCATIONAL SPECIALIST DEGREE

Purpose. The Educational Specialist degree is designed to provide advanced training to students in three areas: Educational Administration and Supervision (Educational Leadership), Elementary Education, or Secondary Education (English, History, or Social Sciences).

Admission. Requirements for admission are

- 1. A master's degree from an institution fully accredited by one of the recognized accrediting agencies;
- A Class AA teaching certificate, or its equivalent, in the appropriate field; (Students applying to the Ed.S. program may be exempt from this requirement provided they meet special prerequisite requirements.)
- A grade point average of 3.25 on coursework completed for the master's degree.
- A satisfactory score on a nationally recognized, standardized test of verbal skills

Degree Requirements. A candidate for the Educational Specialist degree is required to meet the following:

- Fulfill the general requirements for a graduate degree at Delta State University;
- 2. Complete a minimum of 30 semester hours of graduate work beyond the master's degree, at least one-half of which must be 700-level courses, consisting of 6 hours of core courses and 24 to 27 hours in major subject area and electives as are required by the major field division (Educational Administration and Supervision, Elementary Education, and Secondary Education). 500-level courses are not acceptable on the Educational Specialist degree program. Students enrolling in the Secondary Education major will determine an area of concentration (English, History, or Social Sciences). Elective courses to complete a program of study in the concentration area will be determined in collaboration with the program coordinator;
- Maintain a grade point average of at least 3.25 on all graduate work attempted toward the Educational Specialist degree;
- Pass a comprehensive examination in the major field during the last term of course work.
