Selected Reference Books

- APA Dictionary of Psychology [BF31 .A65 2007 Ref] a comprehensive reference containing 25,000 entries and includes terms and concepts drawn from a diverse range of subject areas.
- Biographical Dictionary of Psychology [BF109 .A1 B56 1997 Ref] contains information on over 500 individuals who have made a significant contribution in the field of psychology.
- Dictionary of Theories, Laws and Concepts in Psychology [BF31.R625 1998 Ref] provides a baseline set of concepts for examining psychology in terms of laws, theories, principles, effects, doctrines and hypotheses.
- Dictionary of Psychology, 2nd ed. [BF31.C65 2006 Ref] provides definitions for psychological terms.
- DSM-IV-TR / Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, 4th Edition, Text Revised [Ready Reference – RC455.2 .C4 D536 2000 Ref] – DSM-IV is a list of descriptions of mental disorders based on a categorical classification system and specific criteria.
- Encyclopedia of Human Development [HM626 .E53 3 vols. 2006 Ref] Contains ~650 entries with overviews and explanations of the major topics in human development.
- Encyclopedia of Human Emotion, 2 vols. [BF531 .E55 1999 Ref] covers information about the nature, causes, expression and societal role of emotions.
- Encyclopedia of Mental Health [RC437.K34 2008 Ref] Provides an overview of mental health topics along with a resource section for more information on the topics covered.
- Encyclopedia of Psychology, 8 vols. [BF31 .E52 2000 Ref] provides an overview of the field of psychology including methods, findings, advances in research and applications.
- Tests in Print VII: An Index to Tests, Test Reviews and the Literature on Specific Tests [Z5814 .E9 T47 2006 Ref] a comprehensive bibliography of currently available testing products. It also contains an index for all 16 books in the Mental Measurements Yearbook series.

- Mental Measurements Yearbook (1989-present) [EBSCOhost] Off-Campus Full-Text provides information and reviews on over 2,000 educational, psychological, attitudinal, and intelligence tests.
- Psychology and Behavioral Sciences Collection [EBSCOhost] Off-Campus Full-Text provides the full-text of over 550 journal titles that are indexed in PsycINFO
- PsycINFO (1887-present) [EBSCOhost] ^{Off-Campus} contains citations and summaries of journal articles, book chapters, books, dissertations, and technical reports, all in the field of psychology and the psychological aspects of other disciplines.

Along with the subject-specific databases listed above, also consult interdisciplinary databases such as Academic Search Premier and MasterFILE Premier.
