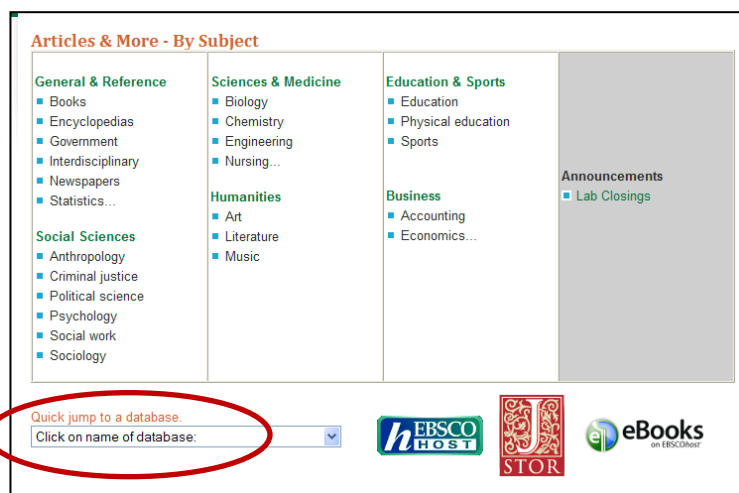

ACCESSING DATABASES

To access a databases, i.e. Academic Search Premier, for full-text, online journal articles:

- Go to the library home page at <http://library.deltastate.edu>
- Look for “Articles & More” on the left
- Click on “Databases By Subject” or go to <http://www.deltastate.edu/pages/676.asp>
- Select the database you wish to search from the “Quick jump to a database” menu.
- After selecting a database, you will be directed to the Remotely Accessible Databases Login Page. (See **Off-Campus Log-In Instructions**, page 2).

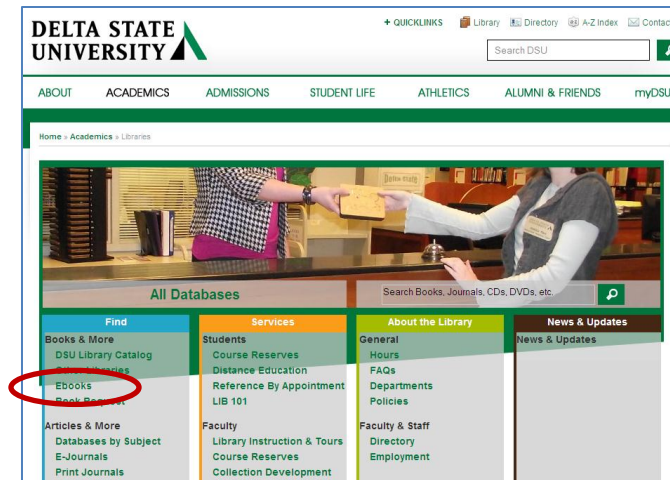

ACCESSING E-BOOKS

- Go to the library home page at <http://library.deltastate.edu>
- Click on the E-books link in the left hand menu under **FIND**.
- You will be directed to the Remotely Accessible Databases Login Page. See **Off-Campus Log-In Instructions** on page 2.
- After logging-in, the EBSCOhost search box will open. Type in your search terms as you would in any EBSCOhost database.



When the Log-In pop-up box appears (*Figure 3*):

- Type in your DSU student or employee ID (900#) without any dashes or spaces.
Example: 900123456
- In the second box, type your six-digit date of birth without dashes or spaces in the form of MMDDYY.
Example: 101487 (For Date of Birth on October 14, 1987)
- Click on “Submit Query.” You should be directed to the database search page.
