- An Introduction to Community Development [HN 49 .C6 I554 2009 Ref] this book covers many topics pertaining to community development. It covers topics within the book's four main parts: foundations, preparation and planning, programming techniques and strategies, and issues impacting community development.

Selected Databases

- Business Source Complete [EBSCOhost] ^{Off-Campus Full-Text} covers all areas of business and economics from over 11,000 journals and magazines and includes author profiles and company reports. Articles pertaining to community development can also be found in this database.
- JSTOR ^{Off-Campus Full-Text} contains articles from journals in multiple disciplines. Articles pertaining to community development also included.
- Regional Business News [EBSCOhost] Off-Campus Full-Text business news from journals, newspapers, and newswires from within the United States. This database includes articles pertaining to community development.
