

Library of Congress Classification

Roberts-LaForge Library uses the Library of Congress Classification. All areas of knowledge are divided using an alphabetized scheme of 21 classes. Each Class is then further divided into subclasses. The Reference collection is on the first floor on the West side of the building. The circulating collection is divided between floors. Classes **A-L** are on the South Side of the *first* floor. Classes **M-Z** are on the North side of the *second* floor.
