#### May 2015 Graduates

If graduation requirements will not be completed by April 3, 2015, it is imperative that you contact the Registrar's Office to inactivate your application. <u>THIS FEE WILL NOT BE REMOVED</u> <u>AFTER THIS DATE</u> and an additional \$45 fee will be charged when you submit a new graduation application. FEES MUST BE PAID BY May 8, 2015.

#### **Diplomas:**

All diplomas will be mailed, unless the student notifies the Registrar's office that they will pick up the diploma, between June 15<sup>th</sup> and June 29<sup>th</sup>. Students should email <u>Inichols@deltastate.edu</u> to indicate that they wish to pick up their diploma from the Registrar's office between the specified times. No diplomas will be given out prior to June 15<sup>th</sup>.

Doctoral, Specialists, and International students (only) will be allowed to pick up their diplomas immediately following graduation and the week of May 11<sup>th</sup> through May 15<sup>th</sup>.

No diplomas will be mailed or handed out unless all fees have been paid and all student holds have been cleared.

#### Cap and Gown:

All student regalia must be ordered through Jimmy R. Williams Bookstore.

Regalia costs are listed below and are broken down by degree type. **Regalia orders and payments are due by Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm** and can be placed with the bookstore beginning March 2<sup>nd</sup>. Phone orders are accepted by calling 662-846-4640. **Regalia will not be ordered until payment has been received.** 

Regalia rental orders and payments can only be made directly to the bookstore. Commencement fee of \$45 paid online <u>DOES NOT</u> include regalia rental fees.

### A \$15 late fee will apply to all orders received Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup> thru Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup>. A \$25 late fee will apply to all orders received on or after Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### All holds must be cleared from your student account in order to receive your cap and gown.

#### TICKETS:

Each graduate will be issued tickets for their guests. The number of tickets will be determined by actual number of graduates. If there are any extra tickets available, they will be given out on a 'first come, first serve' basis at graduation rehearsal. NO GUEST WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE COLISEUM WITHOUT A TICKET.

#### **Ticket Pick up:**

Where: Registrar's Office, KWH 152 Date: Wednesday May 6<sup>th</sup> to Friday May 8<sup>th</sup> Time: 10 am

- Tickets pick up will end at 2:30pm Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup> prior to graduation practice. Pick up will resume after practice is complete.
- Tickets may also be picked up beginning at 8:00 am the day of graduation until 9:30am.
- All holds must be cleared from your student account in order to receive your tickets.
