## <u>DELTA DOWN & DIRTY WAIVER AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS</u>, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT

Please read this document carefully, as it affects your future legal rights, and provide your initials on each line after reading. By signing below, you (on behalf of yourself or your minor child/ward and any personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin) acknowledge, agree and represent that you have carefully read and fully understand the waiver and agreed to its terms.

The waiver must be carefully read and signed in consideration of being permitted to enter a participant or child in the **Delta Down and Dirty** ("Event") and associated property ("Premises"). As used herein, the term "Releasees" is defined to include the following: (i) Delta State University, its subsidiaries, affiliated companies, faculty, staff, students, past and present employees, representatives (Collectively "DSU"); (ii) the Premises owner; (iii) any event volunteers; (iv) any event sponsors, sponsors affiliates and contractors, and their respective employees; and (v) the Board of Trustees, State Institutions of Higher Learning.
