- Must complete 8 semesters of MUS 104 to graduate. Must earn a grade of C or higher in all music courses.
- Must be in major ensemble each semester. Grade of B or higher in major ensemble is required to keep music scholarship. Only 2 hours of ensemble credit may be used for music elective requirement.
- MUS 105 fulfills the General Education Fine Arts requirement. PHI 201 is required for the BA.
- Foreign Language 101 meets Gen Ed Personal Development requirement; 12 hours of foreign language required. 2 years of high school foreign language study can be used as credit for 6 hours of 100-level courses, but does not exempt Personal Development requirement. 2 semesters of sign language may be used to partially satisfy foreign language requirement.
- If senior recital used as project for MUS 490, applied study (AMU) must be used for all 8 hours of music electives with at least 2 hours at 300-level, prior to capstone semester.
- NOTE: University and state-supported Financial Aid programs may require 15 hours per semester
