- **Personal Development:** Select one: SHS 360; CEL 300; CIS 205; FCS 215/270/325/343; SWO 101/300; Foreign Language 101 OR select two: PER 100/101 level activity. Option to enroll in SSC 469/470/499 in fall or spring of senior year. Option to enroll in CRJ 480 in fall or spring of senior year.

- **SPECIAL DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:** Foreign language: One language may be satisfied with 6 hrs at 200-level if 2 years of language is completed in high school. 9 hours if Foreign Language 101 completed to meet general ed requirement for Personal Development. Must be in same language.
