- May repeat no more than 3 courses (9 sem hrs) for purpose of grade improvement. May not take courses at other institutions for grade improvement.

- No grade lower than C in required major course will be applied for credit toward graduation.

- Academic Map serves as tool to assist students in successful matriculation through SHS. It should not be used as substitute for meeting with your Academic Advisor.

- Detouring from Map may result in slower matriculation; however, Academic Advisor may deem it necessary for your academic success.
