- Must complete 8 semesters of MUS 104 to graduate.
- Must earn a grade of C or higher in all music courses.
- Must be in a major ensemble every semester, except semesters of directed teaching.
- Must enroll in MUS 380 every semester.
- MUS 380 counts as a minor ensemble.
- A grade of B or higher in the major and minor ensemble is required to keep a music scholarship.
- A 300-level barrier exam must be passed to enroll in AMU 335 (generally at the end of the 4th semester of AMU 135).
- Must complete 6 hours of AMU 335 to graduate.
- MUS 105 fulfills the General Education Fine Arts requirement.
- Must complete 4 exam areas of the Piano Proficiency.
- Must be enrolled in a piano class or MUS 300 until all exam areas are passed.
- NOTE: University and state-supported Financial Aid programs may require 15 hours per semester.
