- What do you enjoy most about graphic design?

- Who has influenced your design the most? Who is your favorite designer?
- Tell me about a project you've worked on that you felt especially passionate about.
- Do you have the ability to do "non-computer" thumbnails or sketches?
- What is the best compliment you have ever gotten about a design project?
- How do you "sell" your designs? Give an example.
- How many times will you redo a piece before it is finished?
- Can you juggle several projects at once and face extremely short deadlines?
- How much time do you typically spend on projects?
- Tell me about a time when you had a tight deadline in school. How did you handle it in addition to other deadlines and coursework?
- Have you ever missed a deadline? How and why?
- Describe how you would manage graphics related projects that may take several months to complete and that may involve supervision of various subcontractors.
