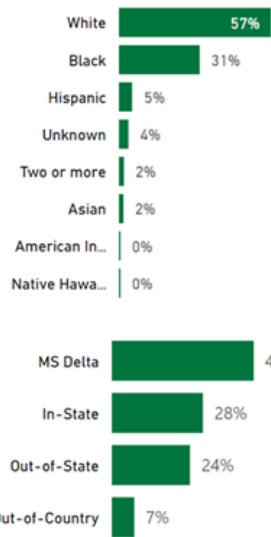
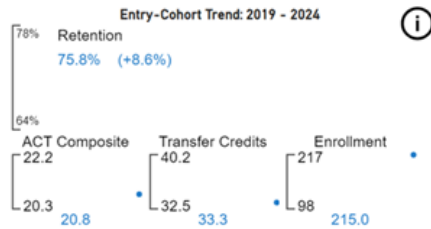

First-Time Full-Time Freshmen & Transfer-In UG Students: Fall Entry 2019 - 2025

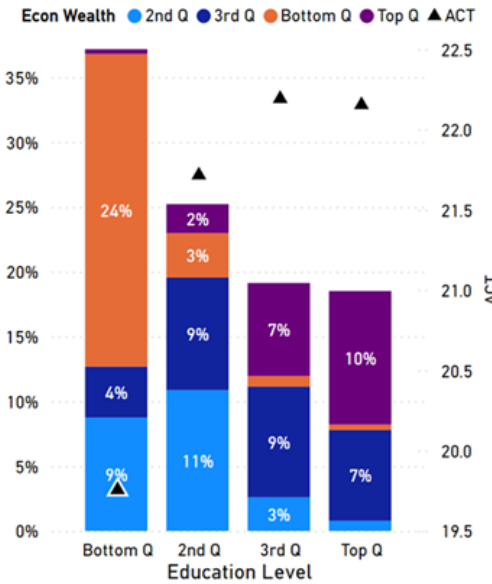

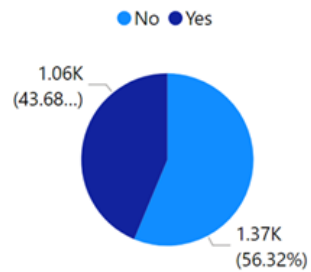

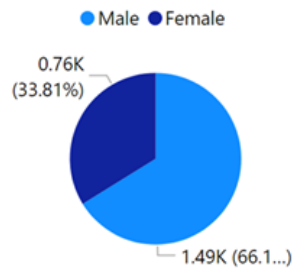

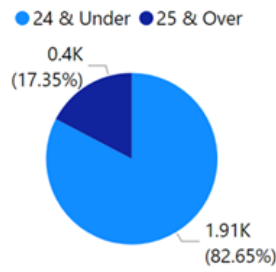

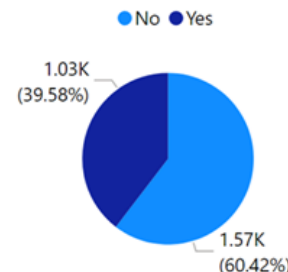

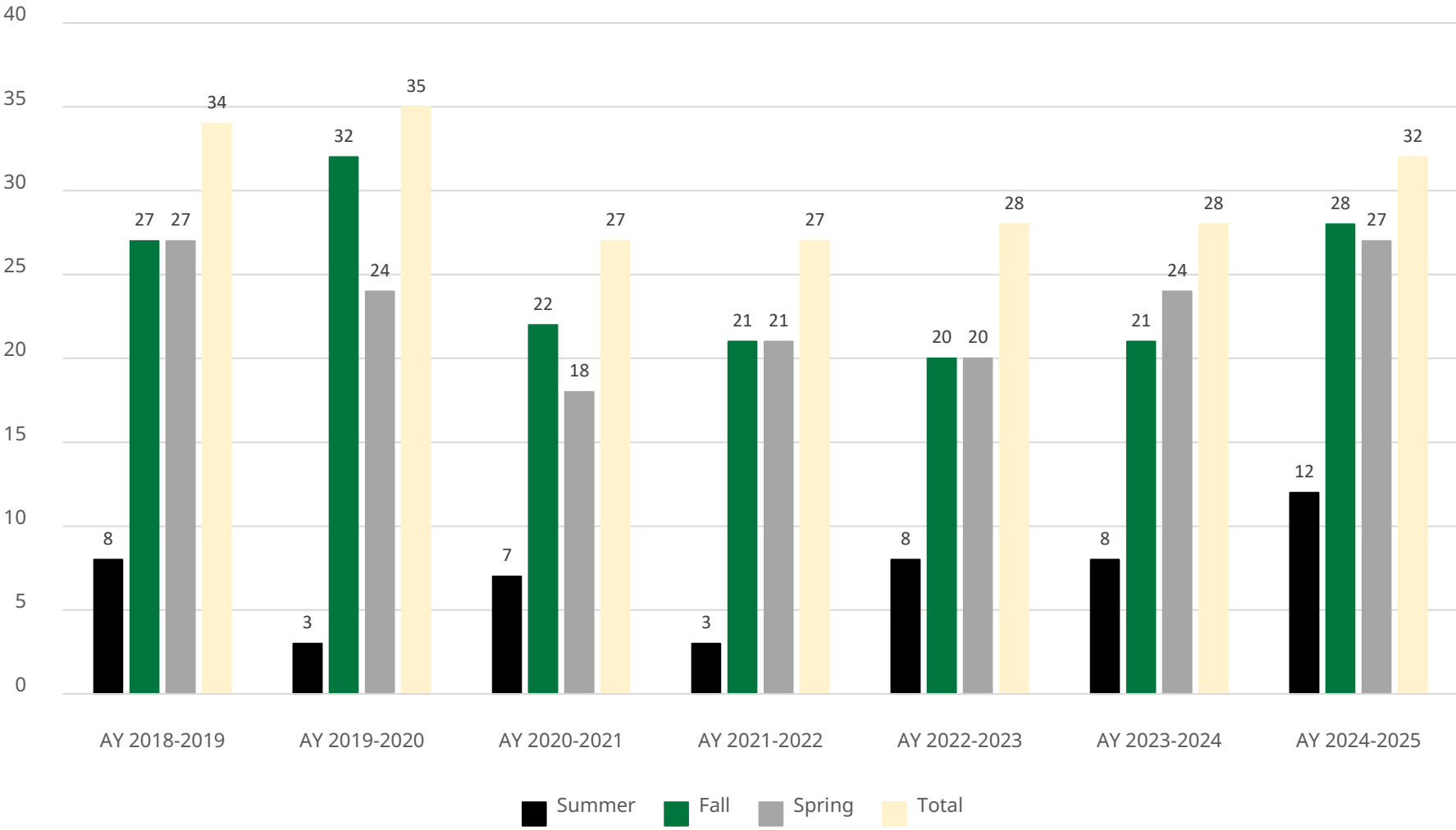

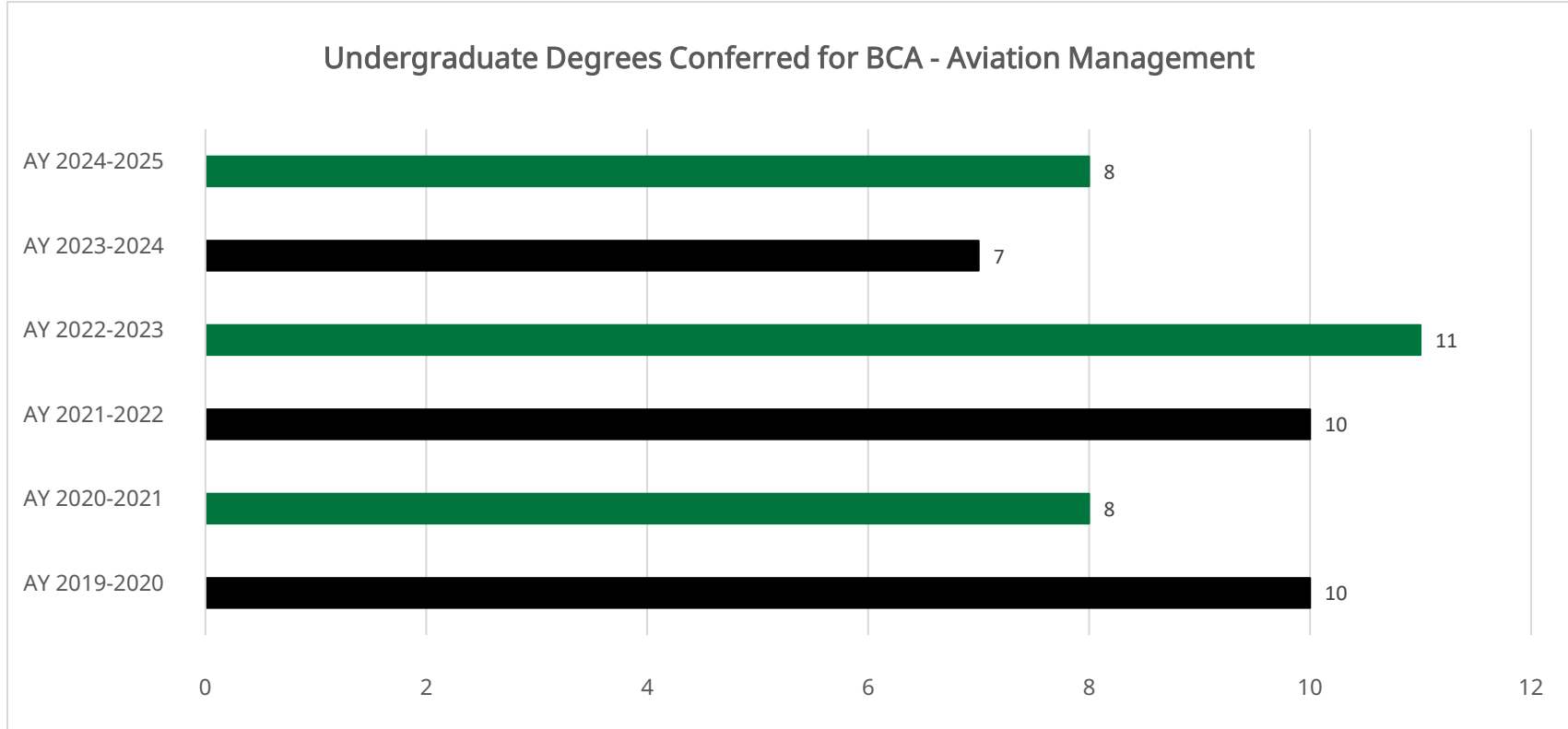
Student Enrollment for BCA - Aviation Management

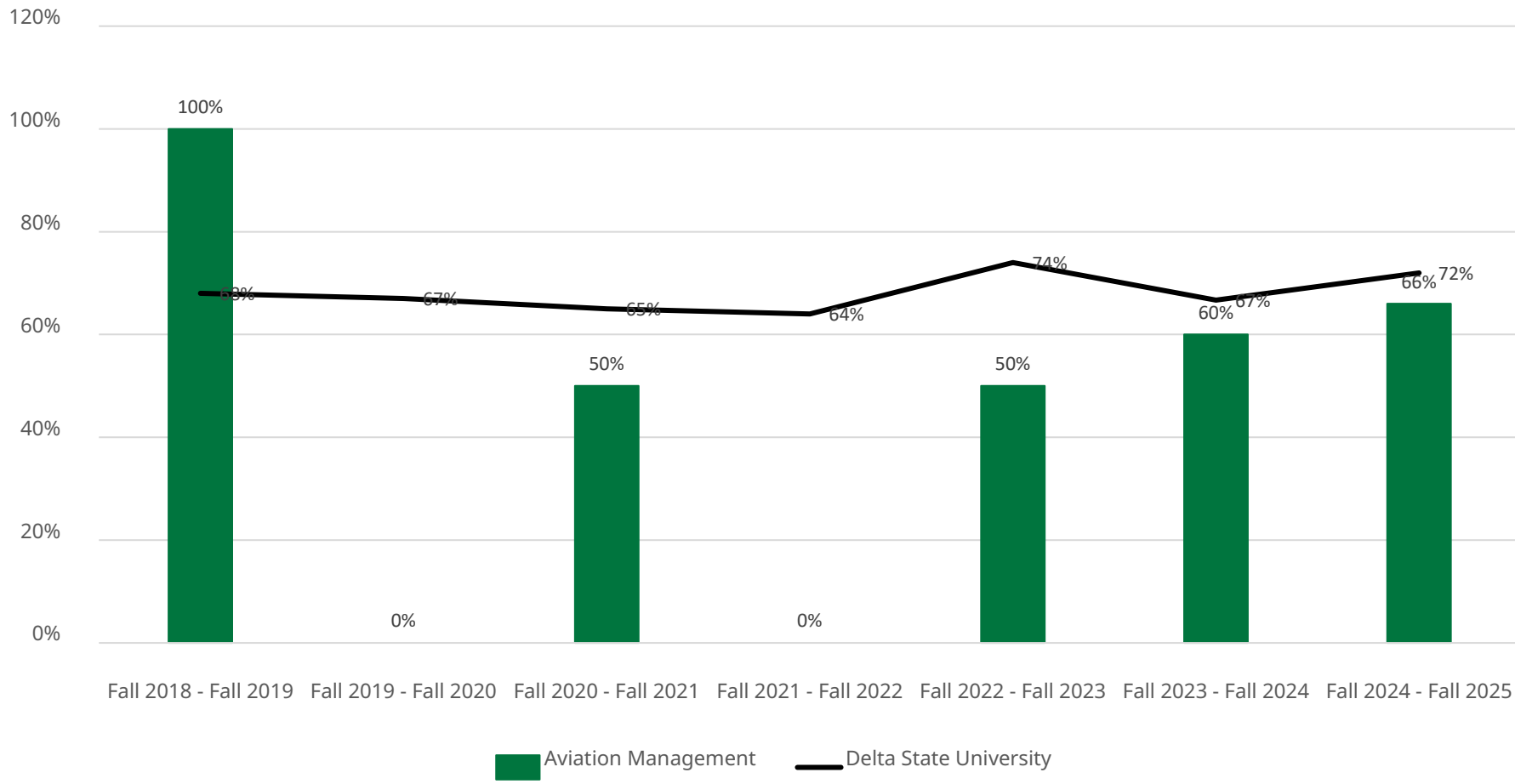
