<u>Call to Order:</u> A regular meeting of the President's Cabinet was held in the President's Conference Room on April 13, 2015. The meeting convened at 1:30 p.m. with President LaForge presiding.

GENERAL OVERVIEW

- President LaForge presented to Mr. Sykes a copy of the minutes and a video of the IHL Board's March meeting where they commended him for his interview on CNN.
- President LaForge announced funding has been received from Mr. Charlie McGuffee to use on a special project, and so we are going to use the money to renovate the SGA offices in the Union during the summer break.
- President LaForge attended the ODK initiation last week, and also met with the Student Presidents' Council group.
- President LaForge traveled to Jackson last week and had several meetings with donors, alumni, and media groups. He also did some recruiting while he was in town. He visited Madison-Ridgeland Academy, attended the Jackson Preview Night, and visited with Park Place Christian Academy and Brandon High School. He had lunch with Charlie McGuffee and Woody Bounds regarding a donation to the Mississippi State University Dudy Noble Stadium project in honor of David M. "Boo" Ferriss. He had breakfast with alumni Renee Deweese, Rob Armour, Arthur Johnston, John Fletcher, Butch Hammack, Mark Houston, and John Kaiser. He also had lunch with Frank Drennan, owner of Capital City Beverages, and he met with Maureen Smith, Director of Communications, at the Catholic Diocese.
- President LaForge judged the Phi Mu/Sigma Alpha Epsilon "Miracle Man Pageant" last week. The proceeds from the pageant will support the Children's Miracle Network Hospitals.
- President LaForge had a conference call with the Gulf South Conference Executive Committee Board, and everything is going well.
- President LaForge welcomed 52 future Delta State Phi Theta Kappa students to campus for their early Registration day.
- President LaForge attended the College of Business' Academic Excellence Awards Banquet.
- President LaForge hosted his final First Friday Faculty meetings for the semester, and he visited with Dr. Ali Reza, Wildlife Management; Jack Phillips, Language and Literature; Dr. Joe Bentley, Physical Sciences; and Dr. Alina Gabryszewska-Kukawa, Planetarium.
- This morning, President LaForge gave a welcome to the TFA Operations Directors and thanked them for their continued relationship with Delta State. He also welcomed a group of seniors from Clarksdale High School to campus.

- President LaForge will meet with Dr. Billy Moore in the College of Business to discuss a proposed Finance Trading Lab.
- President LaForge will be the guest speaker for the Phi Theta Kappa Induction Ceremony tonight at Northwest Mississippi Community College.
- President LaForge announced the arrangements for Dr. Joe Garrison's visitation and funeral services. A moment of silence was held in his memory.
- President LaForge will have lunch and visit with Coahoma Community College students, faculty, and staff this week.
- President LaForge announced that Springfest will be held on Wednesday. It will be on the Quad or in Wyatt Gym if it rains. They will also show the movie "American Sniper" in the BPAC that evening for the students.
- President LaForge will attend a farewell reception and dinner for the four IHL Board Trustees that are rotating off of the Board: Mr. Ed Blakeslee, Mr. Bob Owens, Mr. Aubrey Patterson, and Ms. Robin Robinson. He will also attend the IHL Board meeting on Thursday.
- President LaForge announced Dr. Charles McAdams will conduct the Department of Music's Spring Band Concert on Thursday, and he encouraged everyone to attend.
- On Friday, President LaForge will attend the Inauguration for Dr. Al Rankins at Alcorn State University, and Dr. Gary Bouse will represent Delta State at the Inauguration of Dwaun Warmack, DSU alumnus, at Harris-Stowe State University.
- President LaForge and Dr. Michelle Roberts will visit with the congressional delegation in Washington, D.C. on April 20-21.
- President LaForge announced the date for the three Campus Forums has been changed to April 29.
- President LaForge discussed the rotation schedule for Cabinet members. The Faculty Senate and Staff
 Council representatives will officially change in July after our budget discussions, but both the new and
 past representatives will attend until then. President LaForge welcomed Dr. Leslie Fadiga-Stewart, the
 new Faculty Senate President, to her first Cabinet meeting.

Mississippi Economic Council's Annual MeetingDr. Roberts

Dr. Roberts discussed our sponsorship of the meeting which will be held on Thursday, April 30th in Jackson. Delta State alumnus, Mr. David Abney, is the keynote speaker. She reported that we have eight seats available, and asked Cabinet Members to contact Mrs. Emerson if they would like to attend.

- President LaForge asked Mr. McClellan to thank the Facilities Management Grounds Crew for the excellent job they are doing with the campus.
- Dr. Roberts discussed the legislative session. Our previous line items in the budget were approved: Aviation, Delta Center, and E-learning. The Delta Music Institute received line-item funding this year, as well. Delta State is scheduled to receive \$408,099 for capital improvements, and it is estimated that Delta State will receive funding for a 2.22% salary increase.
- Mr. Sykes reported that the newly-elected SGA officers will finalize their appointments by the end of the week.
- Mr. McClellan announced that budget continuation worksheets will be distributed to the campus tomorrow. They will distribute the Fund 10 budget sheets first, followed by the auxiliary budget sheets.
