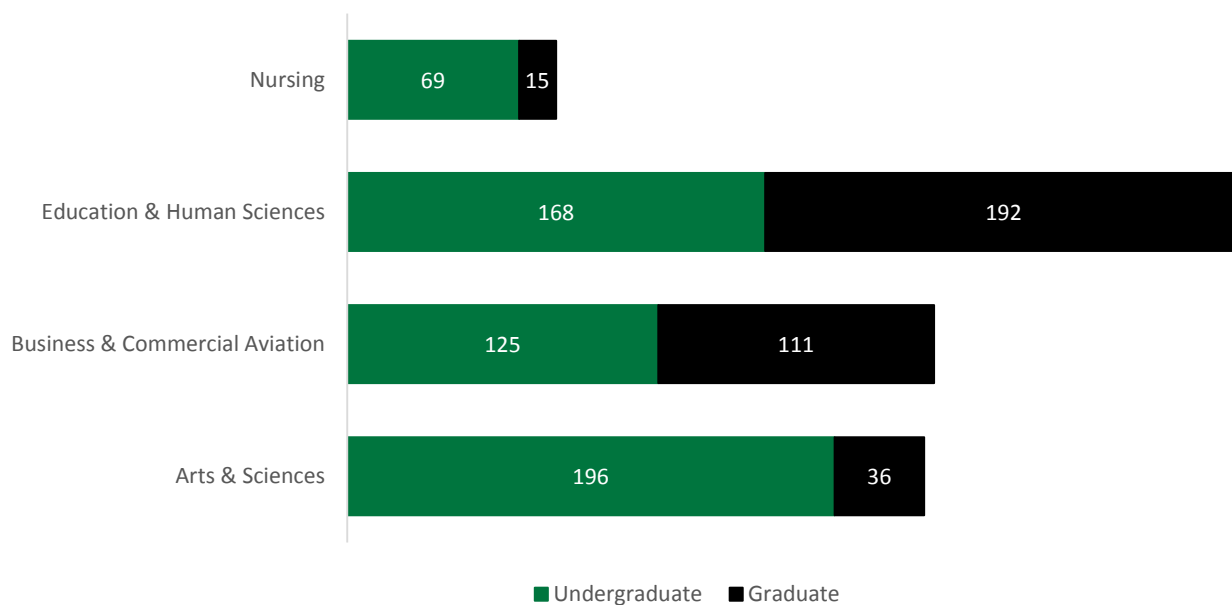

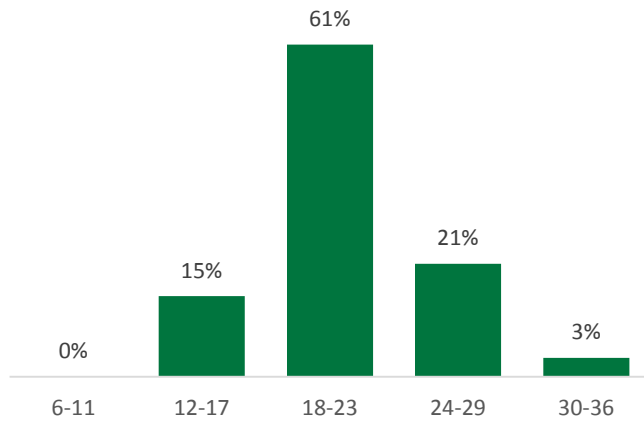

### Fall 2017 ACT Composite Score Distribution



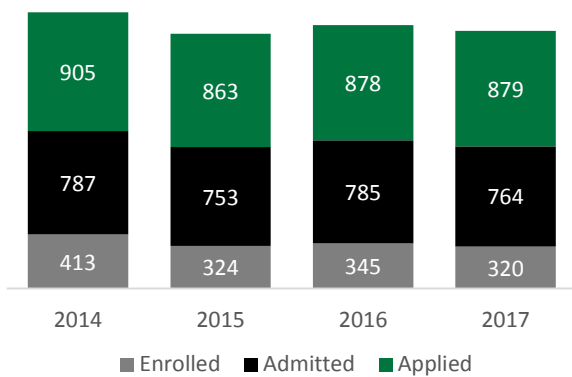

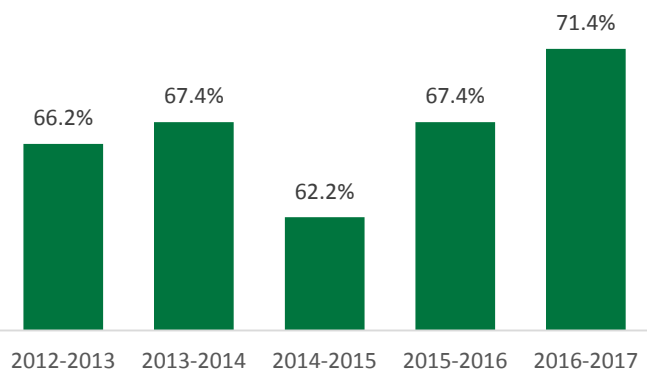

New Freshmen Applied, Admitted, and Enrolled



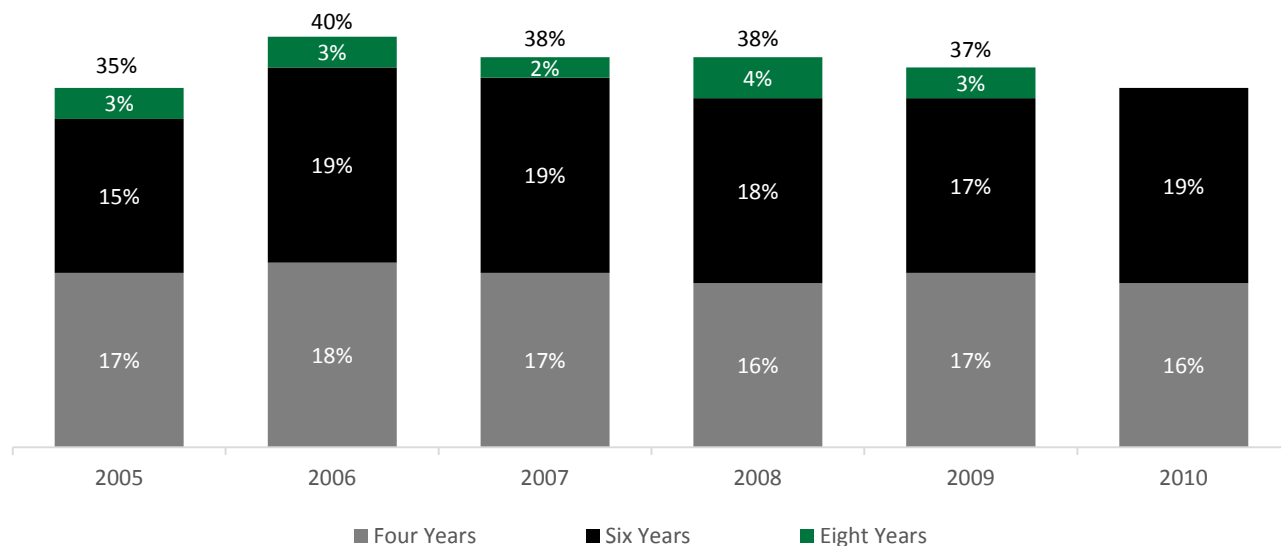
One-Year Retention Rate of Full-Time, Degree-Seeking New Freshmen
