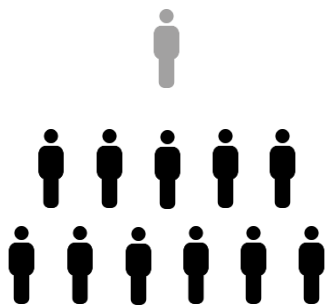

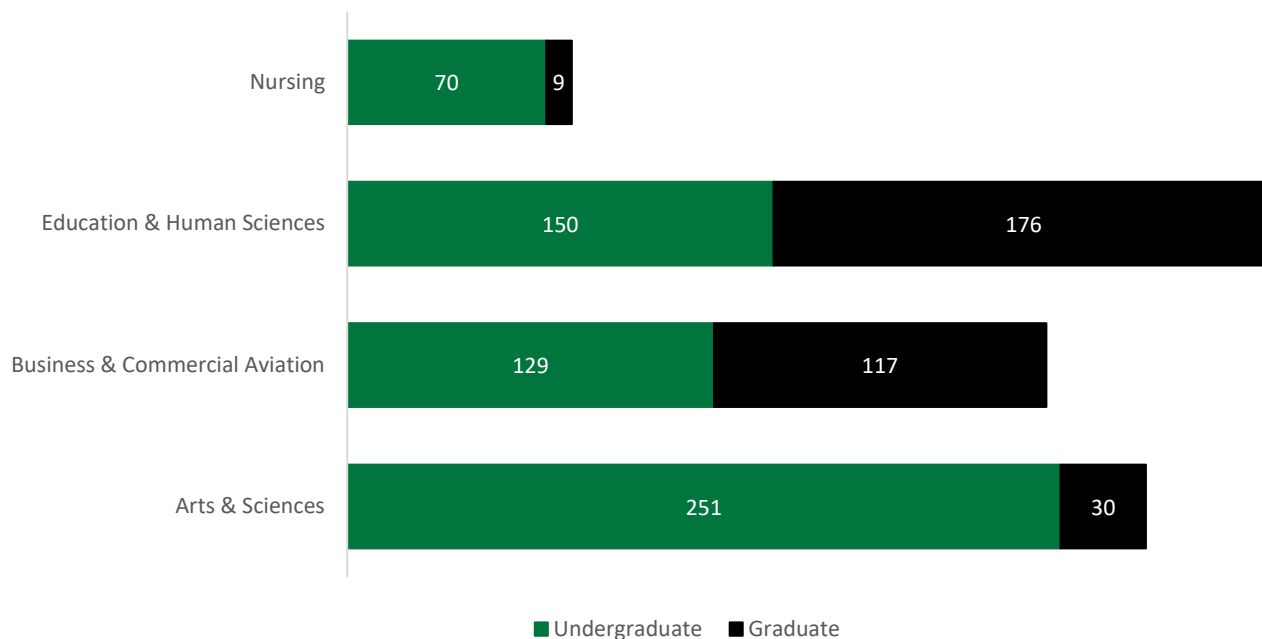

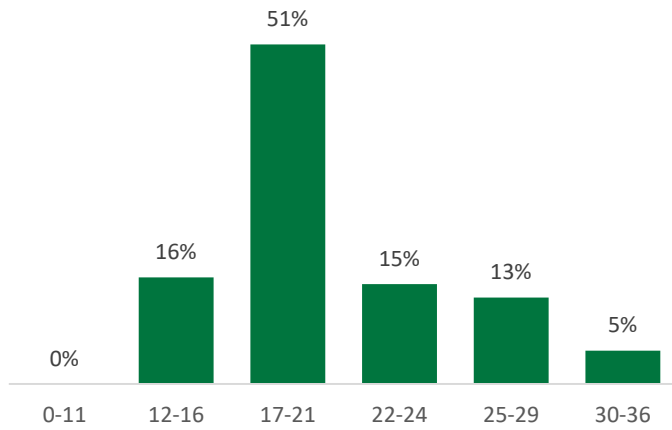

Fall 2020 ACT Composite Score Distribution



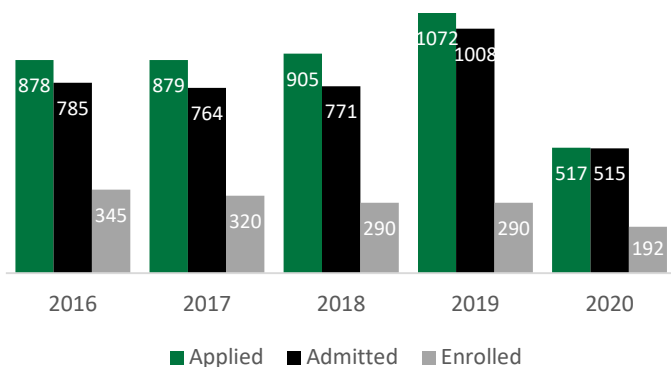

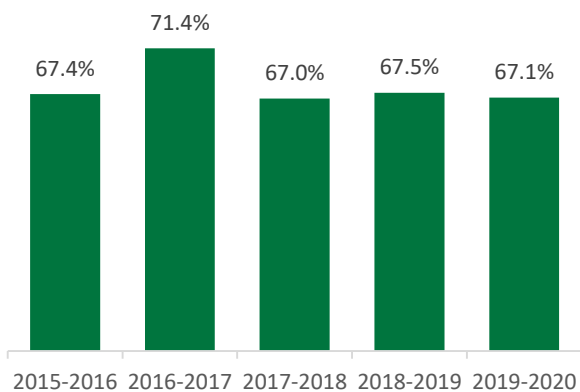
