

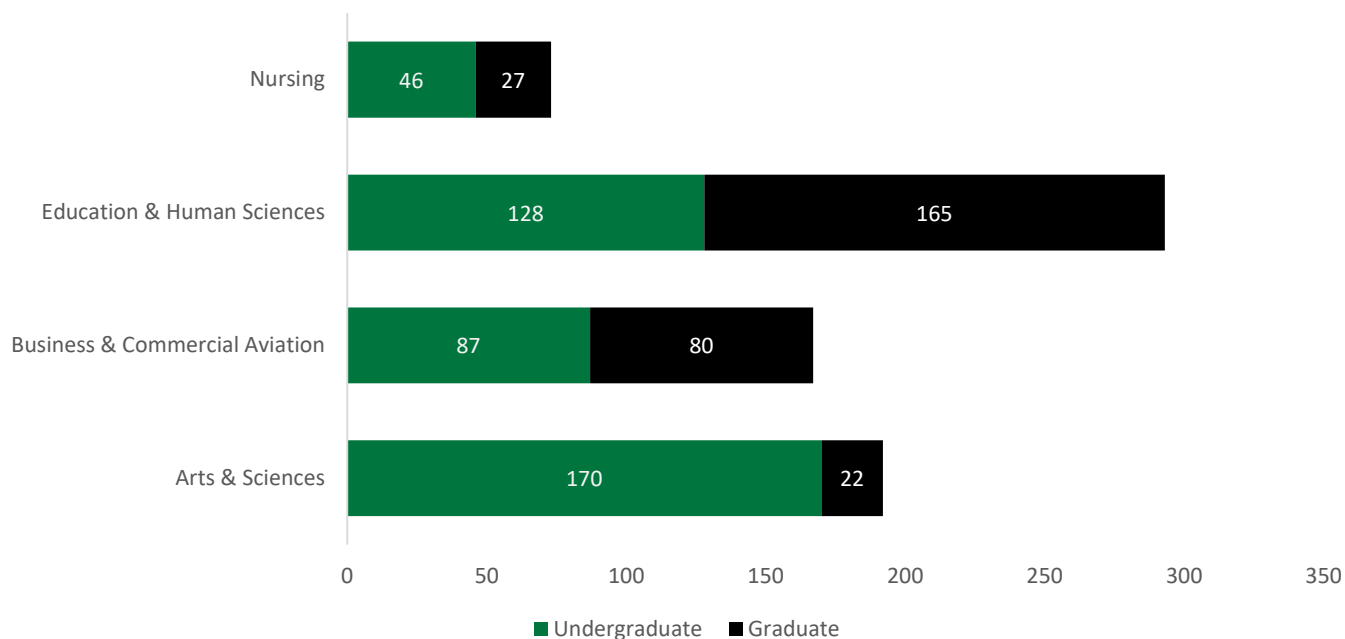

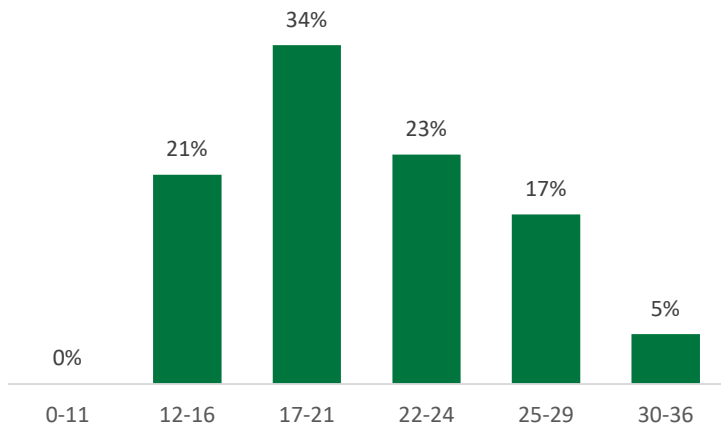

Fall 2023 ACT Composite Score Distribution



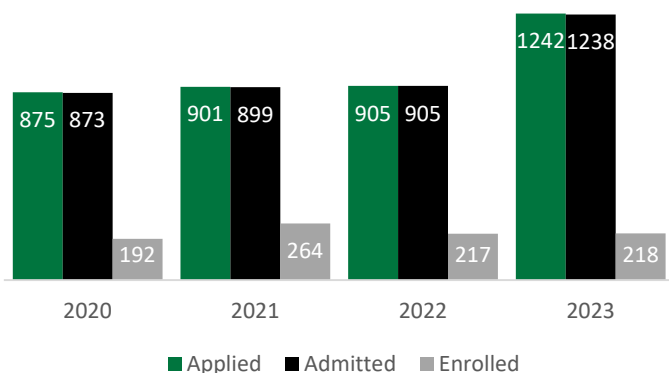

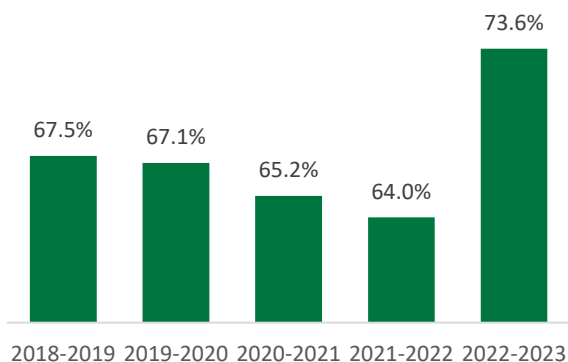
