

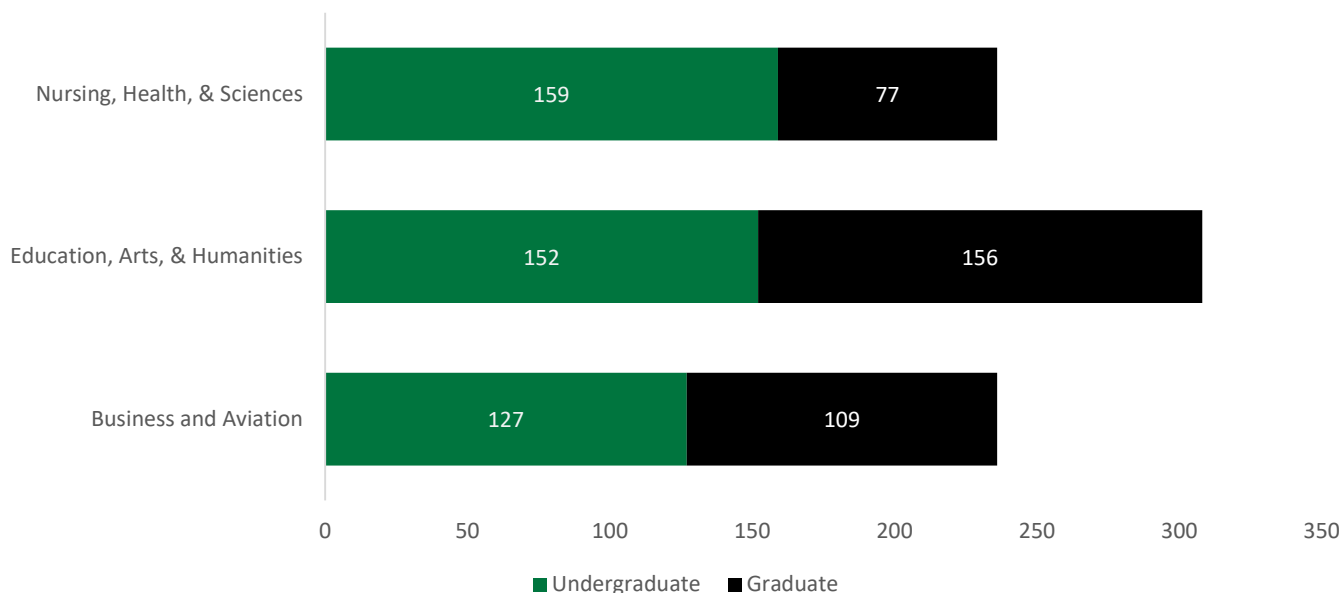

2023-24 Degrees Awarded by College



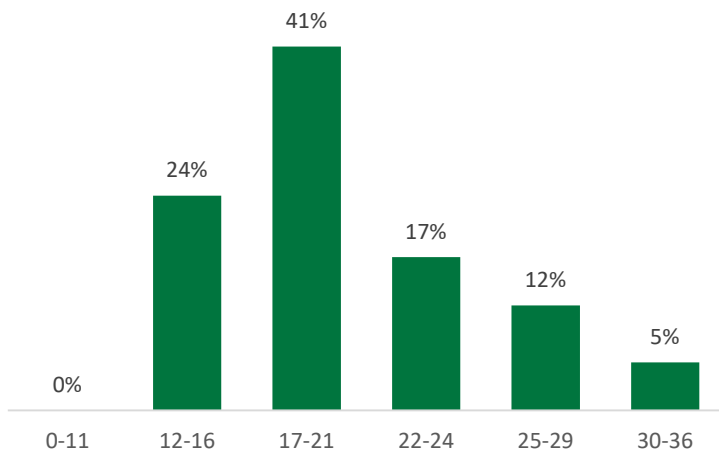

Fall 2024 ACT Composite Score Distribution



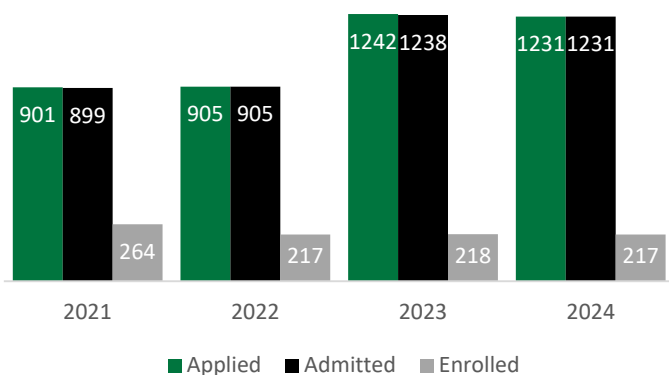

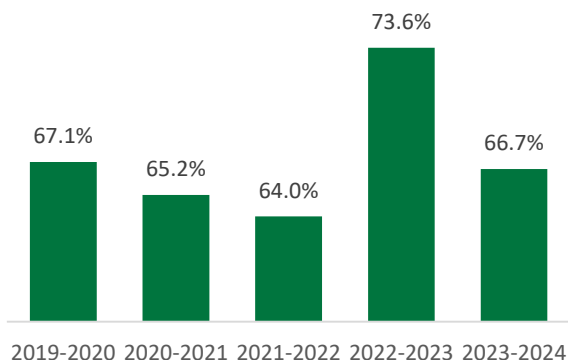
