<u>Call to Order:</u> A regular meeting of the Student Government Cabinet was held in SGA office on April 10<sup>th</sup>. The meeting convened at 8:00 pm with Lucia Chacon presiding.

#### Introduction and Overview of Items

Lucia gave a warm welcome to the newly appointed Cabinet members and allowed each member to introduce themselves. Next, Lucia announced that she spoke to a campus tour this past Tuesday because they were interested in SGA. Next, Lucia went to a Staff Council meeting on Wednesday and presented that Haley Rooks will be the new SGA president. Lucia asked for feedback about the breakfast with Dr. Ennis. Lastly, Lucia announced that she has a BPAC Advisory Meeting Tuesday, and that SGA received a thank you card from Phi Mu for the Miracle Man sponsorship.

## Action

- Adding more seating around DSU campus.......Joseph Anderson
  - The floor was opened for discussion where Joseph Anderson presented the Adding more Seating around DSU Campus resolution. Lucia made a friendly amendment to add the title of the Director of Facilities Management to the resolution. Hayden Kirkhart asked a question about the location of the benches. Advisor Branton made a comment that the locations are subject to change. On motion by Madison Lavoie and seconded by Martina Rossetti, all Cabinet members present and participating voted unanimously to approve this resolution.
- Installing Swipe System in the Forest E. Wyatt Fitness Center......Nicholas Johnson
  - The floor was opened for discussion where Nicholas Johnson presented the Installing Swipe System in the Forest E. Wyatt Fitness Center resolution. Haley Rooks asked a question regarding community member entry. Community members would get a membership card for entry into the fitness center.
