- Library Study Room Chair UpdatesMadison Lavoie

- Touch-less Water Bottle Filing Stations.....Madison Lavoie
 - The floor was opened for discussion where Senator Kyryam Molina presented the Touch-less Water Bottle Filing Stations bill. Lucia made a friendly amendment to section 2 of the bill. The approximate total of all items, such as southern barbecue, salads, dressings, desserts, and cold beverages is \$1,326.64 On motion by Martina Rossetti and second by Shukira King, all Cabinet members present and participating voted unanimously to approve the funds of \$1,326.64 for the International Student Dinner.
- Go Green Weekend DJ.....Lucia Chacon
 - Lucia announced to all Cabinet members that DJ Epic is booked and will not be available for the weekend of Go Green. In replacement of DJ Epic, DJ Brick Q has been contacted and is charging \$200 for 3 hours. On motion by Michael Tucker and second by Madison Lavoie, all Cabinet members present and participating voted unanimously to approve the funds of \$200 for DJ Brick Q to be the Saturday night DJ of the Go Green Weekend.
- Voting on Updated Inauguration Ceremony..... Haley Rooks
 - Haley announced the changes and updates for the Inauguration Ceremony. The ceremony will take place April 27th at 6:00 pm. Lucia announced that this event will be mandatory for all Cabinet members to attend. On motion by Haley Rooks and seconded by Shukira King, all Cabinet members present and participating voted unanimously to approve the updated Inauguration Ceremony.
