All Star Night was successful with a positive overall turnout. Initial concerns regarding snack engagement were noted, and future events would benefit from additional structure and the use of a microphone. Increased collaboration with the Coliseum and the basketball team is recommended.

International Thanksgiving was successful, with increased attendance and student participation compared to the previous year. The STI Awareness Event proceeded smoothly and exceeded expectations regarding the length of time students attended. If held again, consideration may be given to offering free STI testing for students.

The Okra Frost Festival was smaller than anticipated but remained well attended. Earlier planning is recommended should the event continue in the future.

The Strategic Planning Committee met to discuss improving cross-campus communication, with a focus on connecting student organizations through shared messaging and calendar platforms.

During the President’s Cabinet meeting, it was reported that Coliseum construction is expected to conclude in the spring following winter graduation. Over 300 students have transferred for the spring semester, resulting in a 7% increase in commitments and an increase of over 10% in prospects. The Student Success Center is exploring the implementation of designated academic advisors by major to reduce advising gaps. Additionally, promotion for an unnamed artist will begin at the start of the semester in advance of ticket sales and the event.
