

The Mississippi Department of Education is sponsoring a Town Hall Meeting at Jobe Hall on the campus of Delta State University, December 6th. There will be two sessions, one for educators 3:00-4:30 p.m. and one for parents/community leaders 6:00-7:30 p.m. The purpose of this session is to receive input from a variety of stakeholders on the US Department of Education's Elementary Secondary Education Act (ESEA) Flexibility Waiver. Each state has the opportunity to request flexibility from some of the current NCLB requirements on behalf of the state, districts, and schools. States would only be granted flexibility in exchange for rigorous and comprehensive state-developed plans designed to improve educational outcomes for all students, close achievement gaps, increase equity, and improve the quality of instruction.
