## Behavior Policy:

The following discipline rules must be adhered to at all times...

- Respect the property and privacy of other participants. Do not touch others or use their belongings without their permission.
- Disrespecting other children and/or the instructor will not be tolerated. Each child needs to follow directions and do what they are asked the first time they are asked. Being asked twice will result in a ten minute “time-out” and a note sent home to the parent. Being asked three times will result in a parental phone call and the child will be asked to leave.
- Vulgarity (swearing, bad language, etc.), inappropriate touching of others (pushing, shoving etc.) derogatory remarks (dirty jokes/comments, etc.), and harassment (threats, violence, etc.) will not be tolerated and will result in a phone call to the parents and automatic dismissal. If a child is the object of such behavior, he/she must tell the teacher immediately.

Consistent behavior issues will result in your child being dismissed from the program for the rest of the week. Refunds will not be given if the child is dismissed for behavior issues.
