

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Advanced Classroom Management	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
Geared primarily for professionals serving children presenting behavior problems in the school or community, this course focuses on cognitive interventions with an emphasis on teaching students to change their behavior.		
Attention Deficit Disorder	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
This course is designed to help the learner develop a better understanding of ADD and the intervention strategies to facilitate positive student change.		
Autism & Asperger's Disorder	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
This course is designed to help the learner develop a better understanding of the two disorders, intervention strategies to enhance communication and learning, and methods for teaching more conventional behaviors.		
Behavior is Language	4.5 CEU	\$350.00
Designed to give the learner a new perspective on student behavior and effective tools for facilitating positive student change, this course covers behavioral techniques and intervention strategies that remediate disruptive behaviors while increasing classroom control.		
Child Abuse	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
Designed to help the learner identify and effectively teach students affected by child abuse and/or neglect, this course teaches the learner to recognize the signs of abuse and discusses the factors that exist in families who abuse their children.		
Drugs & Alcohol in Schools	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
Designed to give the learner a comprehensive understanding of alcohol, drugs, and their influences in the teacher's classroom, this course provides a framework for understanding what students can experience.		
Educational Assessment	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
The focus of the course is on assessment for instructional programming and will outline procedures for designing or selecting, administering and interpreting, a variety of informal assessment measures typically used in schools for children with special needs.		
Infant & Toddler	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
This course is designed to help educators achieve a better understanding of infant mental health, development, and strategies that can be used to promote positive relationships with children and their families.		
Inclusion	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
This course is designed to help special and general educators gain a better understanding of inclusion, one of the current educational reform movements that advocates educating students with disabilities in the general education classroom.		
Learning Disabilities	4.5 CEU	\$350.00
This course provides an introduction to the field of Learning Disabilities for special education teachers, general classroom teachers, integration teachers and related professionals, especially those working in the areas of language, psychology and counseling.		
Talented & Gifted	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
This course is designed to help the learner achieve a better understanding of the talented and gifted student, methods used in identification and strategies for instruction of these students in an inclusive classroom.		

Teaching Diversity	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
This course is designed to give the learner the knowledge and tools to facilitate a diverse classroom. It covers how to identify different approaches to learning and performance.		
Traumatized Child	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
This course is designed to help the learner identify and effectively teach students in the classroom affected by stress, trauma and/or violence. Learners explore how these factors affect a student's learning and development.		
Understanding Aggression	4.5 CEU	\$350.00
This course is about violence in America and the aggression in schools, streets, and homes. It includes topics on violence, aggression, youth gangs, the influence of drugs and alcohol, and "hot spots" that breed violence.		
Violence in Schools	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
Designed to give the learner a better understanding of violence and intervention strategies, this course provides an overview of violence and the purposes of aggression.		
Reading Fundamentals 1	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
The purpose of this course is to improve your knowledge of science and the scientific process. This is the first in a 3-course series to promote positive relationships with children and their families.		
Reading Fundamentals 2	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
Designed to lay the foundation for effective reading instruction, this course will teach you about the elements of effective instruction and the importance of reading instruction.		
Reading Fundamentals 3	4.5 CEU	\$350.00
This course will focus on learning to read, reading to learn, and an introduction to reading assessment.		
Early Childhood: Family Centered	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
Family-Centered Services will examine the role of early childhood educators and explore ways to build partnerships with parents and create communities of care.		
Early Childhood: Observation	4.5 CEU	\$350.00
This course explores observation and assessment instruments, as well as recommended practices and available resources for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers.		
Early Childhood: Program Planning	4.5 CEU	\$350.00
This course is designed to give you a new perspective on planning and implementing developmentally appropriate programs for young children.		
Early Childhood: Development	4.5 CEU	\$350.00
This course, Early Childhood: Typical & Atypical Development, explores contemporary best practice and perspectives on early childhood development.		
Why DI?	4.5 CEU	\$350.00
An Introduction to Differentiated Instruction. This course provides the framework of and need for creating supportive learning environments for diverse populations. Discussion will include legal, theoretical and pedagogical foundation that support the utilization of DI practices.		
Try DI	4.5 CEU	\$350.00
Follow up course to Why DI? This course is designed to teach the concept of instructional framework & differentiated instruction aimed at creating supportive learning.		
Reading & Writing in Content Area	3.0 CEU	\$275.00
This course offers instruction in teaching reading & writing in various subject matter fields at the secondary level. The material stresses the skills of vocabulary building, comprehension, writing and motivation to read and write.		

Understanding/Implementing Common Core Standards 4.5 CEU \$350.00

This course, Understanding & Implementing Common Core Standards, has been divided into four chapters. The organization of the course covers the rationale for and design of the Common Core State Standards, the “Common Core Mindset” practitioners need for successful implementation, and what specific actions can be taken for deeper implementation across settings.

Harassment, Bullying & Cyber Intimidation in Schools 3.0 CEU \$275.00

This course will discuss definitions and the personal, social, and legal ramifications associated with sexual harassment, bullying, and cyber-intimidation. The course will address what we know about these troubling areas. We will then explore preventative strategies as well as how school staff can address these issues when they occur. A clear understanding of what constitutes harassment and the harmful effects of harassment on people and institutions is essential to providing a safe and inclusive school environment for all.

Teaching Math Conceptually 3.0 CEU \$275.00

This course is designed to expand your methodology for teaching Mathematics. The course will explore an innovative teaching model that incorporates strategies for teaching concepts constructively and contextually. The goal is for you to gain a deeper understanding of the underlying concepts of various math topics and to explore the principles of teaching those concepts to learners. This course will focus on the topics of number sense, basic operations, and fractions.

Teaching Secondary Math Conceptually 4.5 CEU \$350.00

This course will explore an instructional methodology that incorporates strategies for teaching concepts, constructively, and contextually. You will learn teaching methodologies that support federal and state standards and focus on the topics of integers, fractions, factoring and functions.

Response to Intervention: Information for Teachers 4.5 CEU \$350.00

This course provides an introduction to the Response to Intervention process for special education, teachers, general classroom teachers and parents. It provides instruction, structured practice and evaluation.

Six Traits of Writing Model: Teaching & Assessing 3.0 CEU \$275.00

This course will discuss why writing is important and why teachers should include writing in all content areas, practical applications for assessing and teaching writing, and teaching students how to self-assess their own writing. Throughout the course, we will look at practical ways to use this model in the classroom.
