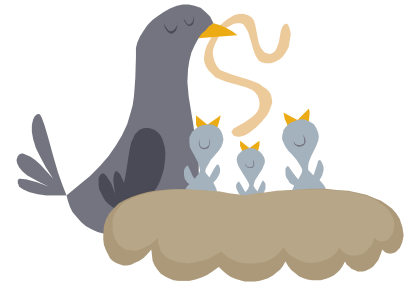


Wildlife Management Interview Questions
