



2016 ORIENTATION

LEADER QUALIFICATIONS, REQUIREMENTS, and APPLICATION

1. Must be a full-time student in Good Academic Standing with the University.
2. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher the semester applying. Failure to meet this requirement will void the application.
3. Must have completed a minimum of 30 hours by the end of the fall semester 2015 and be a returning student in the fall semester of 2016.
4. Must attend a weekend-long Orientation Leader Retreat during the Spring 2016 semester (no exceptions).
5. Must attend the Orientation Leader training class once a week during the spring semester (3 hour credit will be given at the end of the following summer Orientations). Class time will be set by the Director of Student Life after reviewing Spring 2016 class schedules of those chosen.
6. Must be fully committed to giving your 2016 summer to Orientation; Leaders must attend all summer Orientation sessions (no exceptions), workdays before and during these sessions (approximate dates: May 20, 2016 – July 30, 2016).
7. All applicants must attend a general meeting on Wednesday, November 11th at 5:00 p.m. in H. L. Nowell Union 306. If you cannot attend this meeting, you must see Jeanna Dacey Wilkes, Director of Student Life, prior to the meeting or your application will be void.
8. ALL applications must be submitted with two attached recommendation letters; one from a faculty/staff (cannot serve in your academic major) and one from a fellow peer (if Greek, cannot be a member of same Chapter).

ALL applications w/ attached recommendations must be returned to the Office of Student Life, H. L. Nowell Union 200 no later than 5:00 pm on Wednesday, November 11th or during the general meeting on the same date.
