Each participant will receive:

- .7 continuing education hours
- Makerspace kit to use in the classroom (\$40 value)
- Youth Entrepreneur curriculum
- \$100 stipend paid to teacher or substitute teacher reimbursement paid to school (NTE \$100) for the first 20 6th-12th grade teachers that sign up for each workshop & implement what they learned at their school.

Other important info:

- Teams will present to a panel of judges as part of the workshop.
- The winning team at each workshop as determined by the judging panel will receive a team prize of \$200
- Each workshop is limited to 20 participants.
