

## Workforce Development for the Special Needs Student



The MS Council on Economic Education is offering this one-day workshop on entrepreneurship for **special education teachers in the MS Delta Region**. Special Education teachers that attend will have the opportunity to apply for up to \$500 in seed funds to start a classroom based business. These businesses will give special needs students the opportunity to learn skills needed to either operate a business or to be a good employee for another organization. Funds generated by the operation of the school based business may be distributed to the students working in the business as a paycheck, reinvested in the business or used to provide learning experiences for the students.
