Adult Mental Health First Aid is an international, evidence-based program that teaches you how to identify, understand, and respond to signs of mental health and substance use challenges among adults. Learners will complete a 2-hour, self-paced online course, and participate in a 4.5-hour, instructor-led training either via Zoom or in-person.
