

2017 ORIENTATION

LEADER QUALIFICATIONS, REQUIREMENTS, and APPLICATION

- 1. Must be a full-time student in Good Academic Standing with the University.
- 2. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher the semester applying. Failure to meet this requirement will **void** the application.
- 3. Must have completed a minimum of 15 hours by the end of the fall semester 2016 and be a returning student in the fall semester of 2017.
- 4. Must attend a weekend-long Orientation Leader Retreat during the Spring 2016 semester (no exceptions).
- 5. Must attend S.R.O.W. with the Director of Student Life and OL team, held during Spring Break 2017 weekend.
- 6. Must attend the Orientation Leader training class once a week during the spring semester. Class time will be set by the Director of Student Life after reviewing Spring 2017 class schedules of those chosen.
- Must be fully committed to giving your 2017 summer to Orientation; Leaders must attend all summer Orientation sessions (no exceptions), workdays before and during these sessions (approximate dates: May 20, 2017 – July 30, 2017).
- 8. All applicants must attend a general meeting on Wednesday, November 16th at 5:00 p.m. in H. L. Nowell Union 306.
- 9. ALL applications must be submitted with **two** attached recommendation letters; one from a faculty/staff (<u>cannot</u> serve in your academic major) and one from a fellow peer (if Greek, <u>cannot</u> be a member of same Chapter).

<u>ALL applications w/ attached recommendations must be returned to the Office of</u> <u>Student Life, H. L. Nowell Union 200 no later than 5:00 pm on Wednesday,</u> <u>November 16th or during the general meeting on the same date.</u>
